PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of the Ascension of the Lord.

Until recently it has had been celebrated on 40th Day after Easter, hence "Ascension Thursday" as the Feast Day was affectionally known.

A number of decades ago, the Vatican gave local Diocese's the option of celebrate the feast day a few days later in place of the 7th Sunday of Easter, and progressively more and more Dioceses and Episcopal Conferences have decided to do so.

About 10-15 years ago, the USCCB decided to move celebration of the Feast to Sunday. When it did so, it was one the last Episcopal Conferences in the Western Hemisphere to do so; the CEM in Mexico had done so many years, before. In Italy, the Diocese of Rome celebrates the Feast on Sunday, while the Vatican itself continues to celebrate the feast day on Thursday.

Both sides on the question of when of when to celebrate this feast day say that they are doing so to defend the importance of the Feast. The Thursday "camp" says that it is following a Scriptural Mandate. The Sunday "camp" says that commemorating the event "mid-week" decreases attendance even though its importance is far greater than simply a random Sunday (7th) of Easter. My preference would have been to keep celebration of the Feast Day on "Ascension Thursday" though I understand the other side's point.

So what is the importance of Ascension Thursday to our faith? Well it reminds us of God's trust in us: The original plan for the world was that we were supposed to collaborate with God in constructing the world here in accordance to his plan. The entry of Sin into the world frustrated that plan. Jesus was sent here to fix, or "re-boot" God's plan anew. Having accomplished that, Jesus could go home and leave the further construction of the world to us again, as was the original intent all along. The one difference is that now we get "tech support" from the Holy Spirit.

The importance then of the Feast of the Ascension of the Lord is then that it reminds us of God's confidence in us, that with minimal assistance we can, in fact, successfully complete God's original plan for us and for our world.

Happy Feast to all!

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Estimados Feligreses:

Este Domingo celebramos la Fiesta de la Ascensión del Señor.

Hasta hace poco, se celebraba el cuadragésimo día después de Pascua, de ahí el nombre cariñosamente conocido como "Jueves de la Ascensión".

Hace varias décadas, el Vaticano ofreció a las diócesis locales la opción de celebrar la fiesta unos días después, en lugar del séptimo domingo de Pascua, y cada vez más diócesis y conferencias episcopales han decidido hacerlo.

Hace unos 10 o 15 años, la Conferencia Episcopal de los Estados Unidos (USCCB) decidió trasladar la celebración de la fiesta al domingo. Fue una de las últimas Conferencias Episcopales del Hemisferio Occidental en hacerlo; la CEM de México lo había hecho muchos años antes. En Italia, la Diócesis de Roma celebra la fiesta el Domingo, mientras que el Vaticano mismo continúa celebrándola el Jueves.

Ambas partes, en cuanto a cuándo celebrar esta festividad, afirman que lo hacen para defender su importancia. Los partidarios del jueves afirman que se basa en un mandato bíblico. Los partidarios del Domingo sostienen que conmemorar el evento a mitad de semana disminuye la asistencia, aunque su importancia es mucho mayor que la de un simple domingo (7) de Pascua. Yo habría preferido mantener la celebración de la festividad el Jueves de la Ascensión, aunque entiendo el punto de vista de la otra parte.

Entonces, ¿cuál es la importancia del Jueves de la Ascensión para nuestra fe? Pues nos recuerda la confianza de Dios en nosotros: el plan original para el mundo era que colaboráramos con Dios en la construcción del mundo según su plan. La entrada del pecado frustró ese plan. Jesús fue enviado para arreglar, o para reiniciar, el plan de Dios. Una vez logrado esto, Jesús pudo regresar a casa y dejarnos la construcción del mundo en nuestras manos, como siempre fue la intención original. La única diferencia es que ahora recibimos "soporte técnico" del Espíritu Santo.

La importancia de la Fiesta de la Ascensión del Señor radica, entonces, en que nos recuerda la confianza que Dios tiene en nosotros, que con una mínima ayuda podemos, de hecho, completar con éxito el plan original de Dios para nosotros y para nuestro mundo.

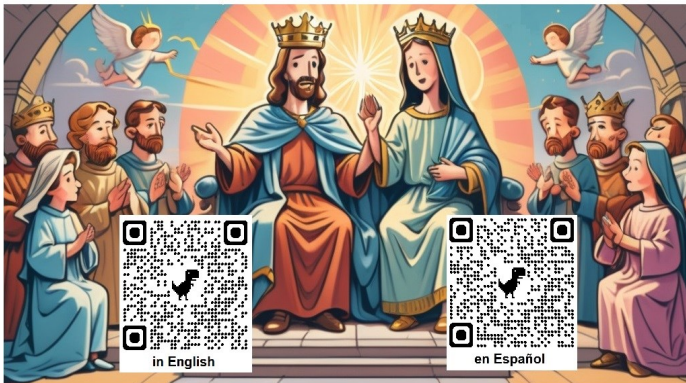
