PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

We find ourselves in this nice tranquil part of the Liturgical Year – mid-summer Ordinary Time – where the Readings, while still quite evocative and at times challenging, are intended to be considered with an air of relaxation and then decision to return renewed ready to once again and perhaps more deeply serve the Lord.

In the First Reading Moses reminds his people that God is not some distant being let alone distant concept, but present to us beside us, in our midst.

The Second Reading, many will recognize as one of the New Testament Canticles that we pray during Evening Prayer in the Liturgy of the Hours, reminding us of the gift of Jesus to us.

The challenging Reading is the Gospel Reading. It starts unassumingly with a scribe asking Jesus what is the most important commandment. Jesus responds with first the Sh'ma (hear o) Israel, that the Lord is God and that we are to love him with all our hearts, being, strength and then to love our neighbor as ourselves.

The challenge come of course in the follow up, when the scribe asks: "And who is my neighbor?"

Jesus proceeds to answer the scribe's question with the Parable of the Good Samaritan, where several people who should have known better choose to avoid a person in need, while someone who the society looked down upon did the right thing and helped the person.

It's a message to foster humility, but also action: If we do see someone in need, we are called to act, and yes, it will often change us and our view of the world around us.

We've had plenty of practice in that here at St. Philip Benizi during the past years.

In the past years, the people coming to our doors, who we all hoped, would not be people who were homeless. Today the issues are more regarding immigrants.

In both cases, written in our hearts is exactly what Jesus would do and asks us to do. It can hurt, it can make us cry, but it also can set us free. And let us always remember that even if we fail the first time, the second time, the third, we can always come back to do the right thing at some point, and God / Jesus will be glad.

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Estimados Feligreses:

Nos encontramos en esta tranquila parte del Año Litúrgico, a mediados del Tiempo Ordinario de verano, donde las lecturas, si bien siguen siendo bastante evocadoras y a veces desafiantes, están pensadas para ser consideradas con un aire de relajación y luego con la decisión de regresar renovados, listos para servir al Señor una vez más, y quizás con mayor profundidad.

En la Primera Lectura, Moisés recuerda a su pueblo que Dios no es un ser distante, ni mucho menos un concepto lejano, sino que está presente junto a nosotros, en medio de nosotros.

Muchos reconocerán la Segunda Lectura como uno de los Cánticos del NT que rezamos durante las Vísperas en la Liturgia de las Horas, recordándonos el don de Jesús.

La lectura desafiante es el Evangelio. Comienza, sin pretensiones, con un escriba preguntando a Jesús cuál es el mandamiento más importante. Jesús responde primero con el Shema (escucha a) Israel: que el Señor es Dios y que debemos amarlo con todo nuestro corazón, ser y fuerzas, y luego amar a nuestro prójimo como a nosotros mismos.

El desafío surge, en el seguimiento, cuando el escriba pregunta: "¿Y quién es mi prójimo?"

Jesús procede a responder a la pregunta del escriba con la parábola del Buen Samaritano, donde varias personas, que deberían haber sabido actuar mejor, optan por evitar a una persona necesitada, mientras que alguien a quien la sociedad despreciaba hizo lo correcto y la ayudó.

Es un mensaje para fomentar la humildad, pero también la acción: si vemos a alguien necesitado, estamos llamados a actuar, y sí, a menudo eso nos cambiará a nosotros mismos y a nuestra visión del mundo que nos rodea.

Hemos tenido mucha práctica en esto aquí en San Felipe Benizi durante los últimos años.

En años anteriores, las personas que llamaban a nuestras puertas, y que todos esperábamos que no, eran personas sin hogar. Hoy en día, los que necesitan nuestra atención más son los inmigrantes.

En ambos casos, está escrito en nuestros corazones exactamente lo que Jesús haría y nos pide que hagamos. Puede dar nos problemas, puede hacernos llorar, pero también puede liberarnos. Y recordemos siempre que, aunque fallemos la primera, la segunda o la tercera vez, siempre podemos volver a hacer lo correcto en algún momento, y Dios/Jesús se alegrará.

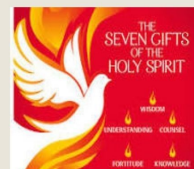

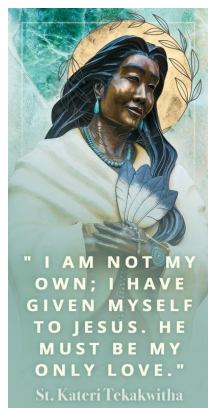

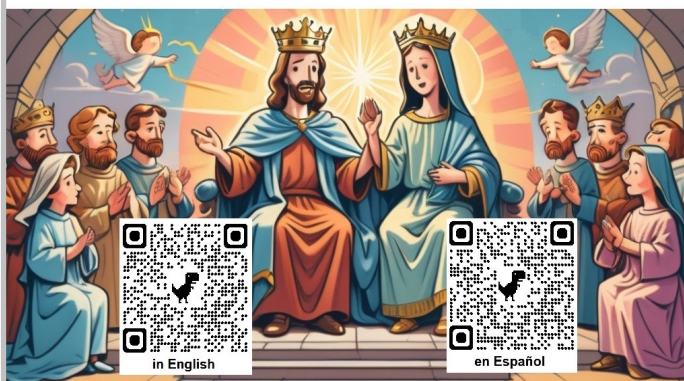
