PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

The Readings today are perfect for the time of year that we find ourselves in -- 16th Sunday of Ordinary Time, in the middle of July.

In this season of “taking in the sun” / “relaxing outdoors” and picnics of all kinds, we hear to two great, improvised meals:

In the First Reading we hear of Abraham, sitting one hot, lazy afternoon at the entrance of his tent near a local tree of some import named “the Terebinth of Mamre” (look it up on Wikipedia or Google) where he ends up having a mystical encounter with the Lord (who appears to him in the form of three persons). Abraham invites the Lord, again, in the form of three persons, into his home, and history to say nothing of iconography is forever changed.

In the Gospel Reading, a woman from Bethany named Martha, with a brother of future fame named Lazarus and a somewhat introverted sister named Mary, invites Jesus, the Lord into her house. And again they have an iconic encounter with the Lord remembered to this day.

On the face of it, both encounters involve inviting someone over for dinner, but of course both come to involve much more – an encounter with God.

We often go through life hoping for exceptional moments to come to us, even as they do, often in the most mundane of ways.

Abraham could have found any number of excuses to not invite the Lord into his house, beginning with perhaps that it was “simply too hot outside” to wondering if they could find food for another three guests (hey, initially, when I saw you, I thought there was only one of you ...). But apparently he and his wife Sarah “found enough lamb” for them all.

For Martha, who actually had done the inviting, the meal appeared to be a bigger challenge than she expected – or she was just annoyed at her sister for not helping out. Still we are reminded that these encounters, including the Eucharist, which both prefigured, were more than the rote meal itself. They were “encounters with (an) other” which turned out to be encounters with the Lord.

It's an invitation to appreciate not merely the Eucharist, but also the person, in the likeness of Jesus, sitting next to us.

So much one can learn from a simple invitation to (an) other.

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos Feligreses,

Las lecturas de hoy son perfectas para la temporada en la que nos encontramos: el 16.º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, en el centro de Julio.

En esta temporada de “tomar el sol,” relajarse al aire libre y disfrutar de todo tipo de picnics, escuchamos dos excelentes comidas improvisadas:

En la primera lectura, leemos cómo Abraham, sentado una tarde tranquila soleada a la entrada de su tienda, cerca de un árbol local de cierta importancia llamado “el Terebinto de Mamre” (búsquenlo en Wikipedia o Google), termina teniendo un encuentro místico con el Señor (quien se le aparece en forma de tres personas). Abraham invita al Señor, de nuevo, en forma de tres personas, a su casa, y la historia, y la iconografía, cambia para siempre.

En el Evangelio, una mujer de Betania llamada Marta, con un hermano que llegaría a ser famoso llamado Lázaro y una hermana bien introvertida llamada María, invita a Jesús, el Señor, a su casa. Y de nuevo tienen un encuentro icónico con el Señor que se recuerda hasta el día de hoy.

Aparentemente, ambos encuentros empezaron con la invitación a alguien a cenar, pero, ambos los llevaron a algo más grande: un encuentro con Dios.

A menudo pasamos por la vida esperando que nos lleguen momentos excepcionales, aunque ellos lleguen a menudo de las maneras muy sencillas.

Abraham podría haber encontrado muchas excusas para no invitar al Señor a su casa, empezando quizás “simplemente hacía demasiado calor” hasta preguntarse si podrían encontrar comida para otros tres invitados (oye hermano, cuando te vi, pensé que solo eras uno...). Pero aparentemente él y su esposa Sara “encontraron suficiente cordero” para todos.

Para Marta, quien hizo la invitación, preparar llegó a ser un desafío mayor de lo que esperaba, o simplemente ella se molestó con su hermana por no ayudar. Aun así, recordamos que estos encuentros, incluida la Eucaristía que ambos prefiguraron, fueron más que la comida rutinaria en sí. Fueron encuentros con el Otro que resultaron ser encuentros con el Señor.

Es una invitación a apreciar no solo la Eucaristía, sino también a la persona, a semejanza de Jesús, que está sentada a nuestro lado durante la Eucaristía.

Cuanto se puede aprender mucho de una simple invitación a un otro!

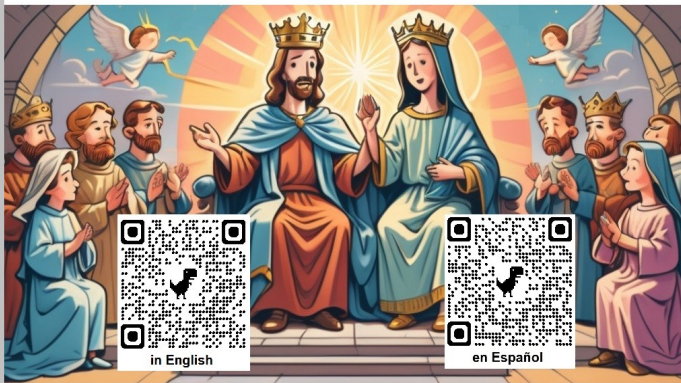
