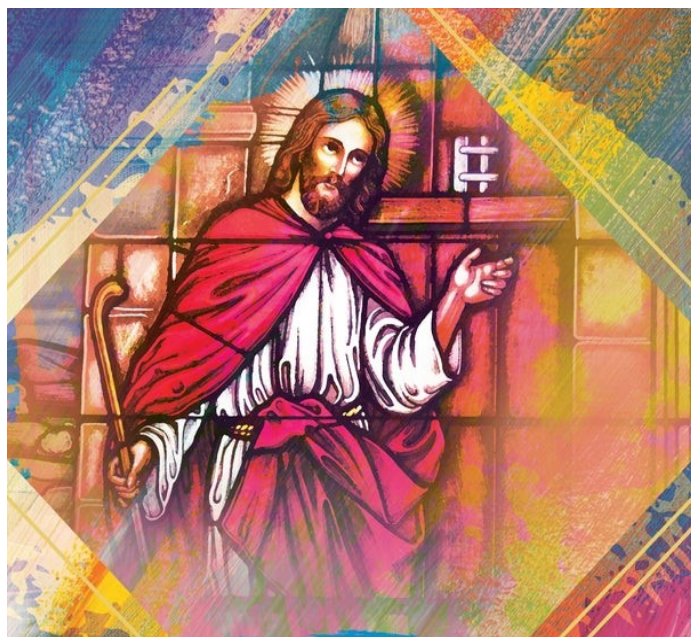

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

We find ourselves at the end of July, a month when the Liturgy anticipated that most of us would be relaxing. And so this is really the last Sunday in which the Readings are relatively un-demanding.

In the first Reading we hear of the story of Abraham bargaining with God over the fate of Sodom, but really over the fate of his nephew Lot who had moved there along with his family in the years previous.

In the Gospel, we hear first Luke's version of Jesus teaching his followers the Our Father. And then we are reminded that God does at least expect us to ask for what we need.

Combined, the First Reading and the Gospel Reading seek to encourage us to not be afraid even in our faith.

That over the years I've found to be rather challenging for most of us, including myself.

It has long been noted that the Jewish faith presented in the Old Testament was far more expressive than the quiet, humble piety that we generally associate with our Christian spirituality.

Abraham's willingness to challenge God, if in a respectful, but purposeful way, is but one example. Many of the Psalms begin with laments and even complaints to God.

Indeed from the Cross we are told that Jesus invoked the 22nd Psalm: "My God, my God why have you abandoned me ...?"

Most of us would probably be afraid to do so ourselves. Yet in the Gospel Reading, Jesus to "ask and you shall receive, seek and you shall find, knock and the door will be open to you."

I remember in college, the lament of many of the women students at the time. They were saying that many of the male students were simply cowards. "How can I say yes to someone who won't even ask me on a date?"

Yes, in dating, one has to understand that the answer may be no. And that may be harsh ... but as we always say, "it builds character."

In matters of God however, "no" is rare and is almost always accompanied with a hug.

Let's not be afraid to ask.

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Estimados Feligreses:

Nos encontramos a finales de Julio, un mes en el que la liturgia anticipaba que la mayoría estaríamos descansando. Por eso, este es el último Domingo en el que las lecturas son relativamente tranquilas.

En la primera lectura, escuchamos la historia de Abraham negociando con Dios sobre el destino de Sodoma, pero en realidad sobre el destino de su sobrino Lot, quien se había mudado allí con su familia en los años anteriores.

En el Evangelio, escuchamos primero la versión de San Lucas de Jesús enseñando a sus discípulos el Padrenuestro. Y luego se nos recuerda que Dios al menos espera que pidamos por lo que necesitamos.

Juntas, la primera lectura y el Evangelio buscan animarnos a no tener miedo, incluso en nuestra fe.

Esto, a lo largo de mi vida, veí que es bastante desafiante para la mayoría de nosotros, incluyéndome a mí.

Muchos han observado desde mucho tiempo que la fe Judía presentada en el Antiguo Testamento era mucho más expresiva que la piedad silenciosa y humilde que generalmente asociamos con nuestra espiritualidad Cristiana.

La disposición de Abraham a desafiar a Dios, aunque de forma respetuosa pero decidida, es solo un ejemplo. Muchos Salmos comienzan con lamentos e incluso quejas a Dios.

De hecho, desde la cruz se nos dice que Jesús invocó el Salmo 22: «Dios mío, Dios mío, ¿por qué me has abandonado...?».

La mayoría de nosotros probablemente tendríamos miedo de hacerlo. Sin embargo, en el Evangelio, Jesús dice: «Pidan y recibirán, busquen y hallarán, llamen y se les abrirá».

Recuerdo un lamento común de muchas de las estudiantes universitarias de mi tiempo. Decían que muchos de los estudiantes varones eran simplemente cobardes. «¿Cómo puedo decirle que sí a alguien que ni siquiera me lo pide a salir (a una cita) con él?».

Sí, en las citas, hay que entender que la respuesta puede ser "no." Y eso puede dar tristeza ... pero como siempre decimos, «forja el carácter».

Sin embargo, en asuntos de Dios, el «no» es poco común y casi siempre va acompañado de un abrazo. No tengamos miedo de preguntar.

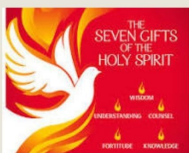

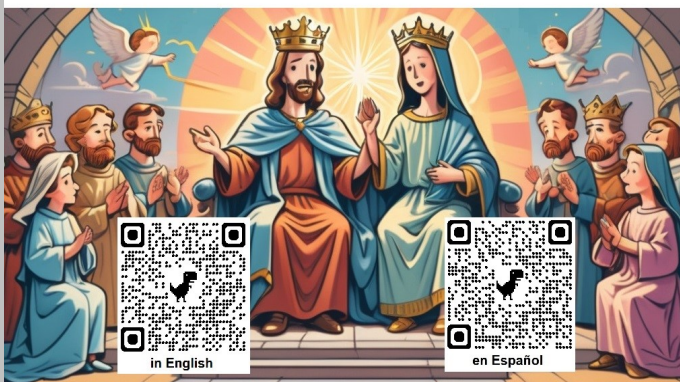
