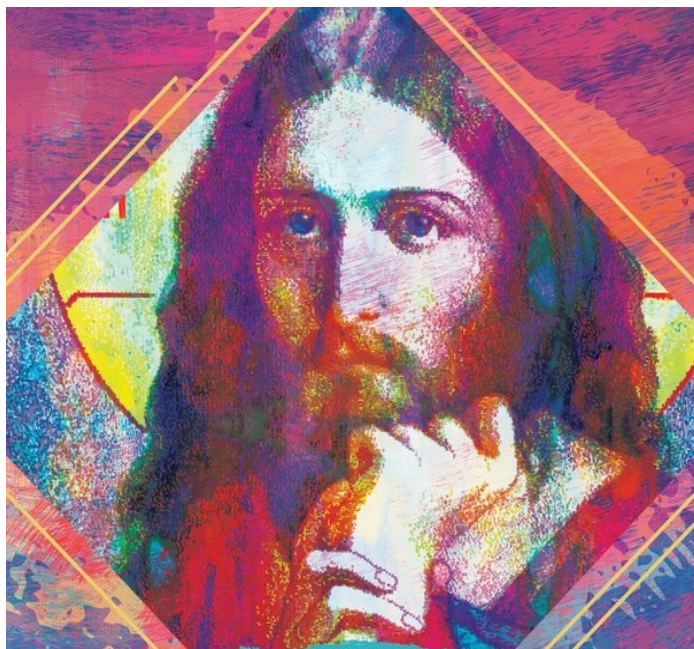

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

We enter into August, and yes, the tone of the Readings change.

If the Readings in the Sundays of July were meant to be relaxing, from now on they will be progressively more challenging.

The First Reading feels as if someone has decided to wake us up from our gentle slumber sitting on our lawn chair, and our first reaction is:

"Oh my, where am I? and trying to regain our balance we at least initially despair 'vanity o vanity, all things are vanity ...'"

But we do have to wake up, and realize that a lot of the things that we spend a good part of our lives are indeed impermanent.

The man in the Gospel reading thinks that he has everything set. He decides to simply store his wealth and looks forward to an indefinite period of lazy afternoons looking toward a bright and tranquil future. Yet Jesus reminds him (and us), that God can kick down the legs of that lawn chair that we're sitting on at any time and so not to look for security in this world.

It's not as if "imprudence is good." It most is certainly not. However, expecting to live a comfortable life, especially in a world still so heavily marked by sin, is really not part of God's plan.

When I hear these Readings, especially the Gospel Reading, I often think of the Marley character in Charles Dickens' Christmas Carol. He had been the partner of Ebenezer Scrooge, whose soul was in peril in the story. Marley comes to him from the dead to warn him that he must change.

Disbelieving at seeing the fate of his old business partner, forced to carry the chains of his past sins for all eternity, Ebenezer tells Marley: "But you were such a good man of business." To which Marley cries out and rattles the chains weighing him down: "Human welfare, the welfare of others should have been my business!"

We all make choices in life, please let us seek to choose well, and to choose to help the people who need us.

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos Feligreses,

Entramos en Agosto, y sí, el tono de las lecturas se cambia.

Si las lecturas de los Domingos de Julio se suponía que debían ser relajantes, a partir de ahora serán cada vez más desafiantes.

La primera lectura se siente como si alguien hubiera decidido despertarnos de nuestro plácido sueño sentados en la silla del jardín, y nuestra primera reacción es:

"¡Ay, dónde estoy! Y tratando de recuperar el equilibrio, al menos al principio nos desesperamos: '¡Vanidad, vanidad, todo es vanidad...!'"

Pero tenemos que despertar y darnos cuenta de que muchas de las cosas en las que invertimos gran parte de nuestra vida son, en efecto, efímeras.

El hombre del Evangelio cree tenerlo todo resuelto. Decide simplemente guardar sus riquezas y anhela un período indefinido de tardes de ocio, con la vista puesta en un futuro brillante y tranquilo. Sin embargo, Jesús le recuerda (y nos recuerda) que Dios puede derribar las patas de esa silla de jardín en la que estamos sentados en cualquier momento, y que por eso no debemos buscar seguridad en este mundo.

No es que la imprudencia sea buena. Ciertamente no. Sin embargo, esperar vivir una vida cómoda, especialmente en un mundo todavía tan marcado por el pecado, no forma parte del plan de Dios.

Cuando escucho estas lecturas, especialmente el Evangelio, pienso del personaje de Marley en el "Cuento de Navidad" de Charles Dickens. Había sido socio de Ebenezer Scrooge, cuya alma estaba en peligro en la historia. Marley se le aparece de entre los muertos para advertirle que debe cambiar.

Incrédulo al ver el destino de su una vez socio, obligado a cargar con las cadenas de sus pecados pasados por toda la eternidad, Ebenezer le dice a Marley: «Pero eras un buen hombre de negocios». A lo que Marley exclama, haciendo sonar las cadenas que lo oprimen: "¡El bienestar humano, el bienestar de los demás, debería haber sido asunto mío!"

Todos tomamos decisiones en la vida; por favor, esforcémonos por elegir bien y por ayudar a quienes nos necesitan.

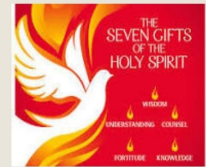

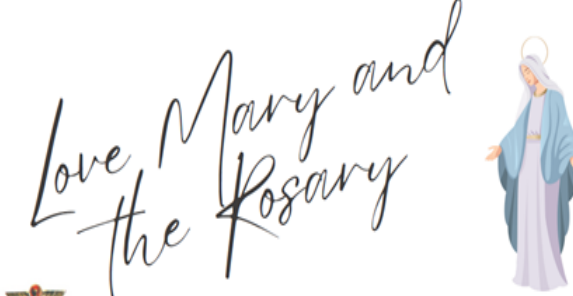

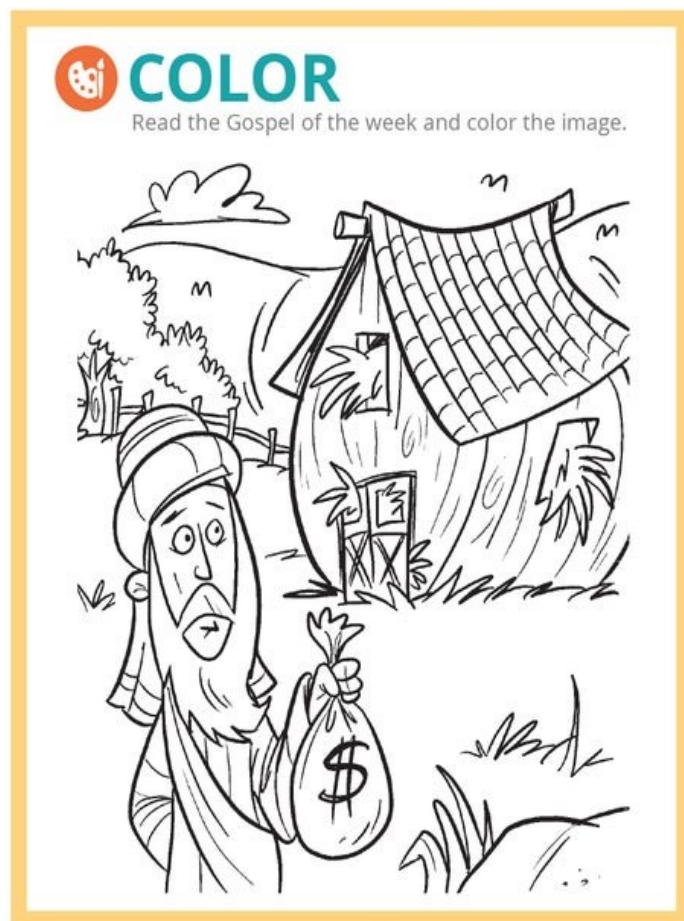
