PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

The Readings today continue the “change in tone” that we heard last week, as compared to the weeks before.

In August, especially in Year C, whose focus is the Gospel of Luke, the Readings progressively become more confrontational and challenging, reminding us that God has expectations of his followers, at minimum as we hear today, to “keep awake” / keep focused.

Jesus notes that the Lord’s judgement on those who do keep vigil will be kind, but harsher on those who come to think that “the Lord is delayed” and begin to pursue various vain pursuits.

What to do then, to focus on loving God and loving neighbor?

Over the years we’ve tried to offer people the opportunity to love / venerate God.

Now only did we just complete our annual Diocese encouraged 24 hours with the Lord this weekend, we have exposition twice a week, in Spanish on Tuesday evenings at the end of the 6:30 PM Mass on that evening, and in English on Thursday mornings after our 8:30 AM Mass.

We also offer Confessions 5x a week, on Mondays, Wednesdays and Saturdays in the mornings after the 8:30 AM Mass, and on Tuesday and Thursday evenings after the 6:30 PM Mass.

With regards to loving our neighbor, we have our very active and, for decades, well supported St. Vincent de Paul Society distributing food / pantry item twice a week, on Tuesday and Thursday mornings, deliveries to the homebound / shut-ins on Wednesday afternoons and providing services in both English and Spanish as needed. The Tuesday and Thursday distributions have become occasions of all kinds of other service providers to come and provide information about the services that they offer.

We’ve also defended and helped both those people who find themselves homeless and immigrants.

And we’ve tried to give support and encouragement to every ethnic group that we have in the parish, to help everyone appreciate that we’re all children of God.

In this regard, I’m very happy that we’re going to have a Halloween Dinner dance this year, despite some objections over the years of some of our non-Anglo communities, to underline the point that God loves us all, and happy memories of all people, including of us, who are simply “from here” deserve to be celebrated.

We have been a community that hopes to underline that all of us are loved both by God, and by us as well. May we continue to serve the Lord and our neighbor in these ways!

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Estimados Feligreses:

Las lecturas de hoy siguen en “el cambio de tono” que escuchamos la semana pasada, en comparación con las semanas anteriores.

En Agosto, especialmente en el Año C, cuyo enfoque es el Evangelio de Lucas, las lecturas se vuelven cada vez más confrontativas y desafiantes, recordándonos que Dios tiene expectativas de sus seguidores, al menos, como escuchamos hoy, que se mantengan despiertos y concentrados.

Jesús señala que el juicio del Señor sobre quienes velan será benigno, pero más severo para quienes piensen que "el Señor tarda" y comiencen a perseguir vanas búsquedas.

¿Qué hacer entonces para enfocarnos en amar a Dios y al prójimo?

A lo largo de los años hemos intentado ofrecer a los feligreses la oportunidad de amar y venerar a Dios.

Acabamos de completar las anuales 24 horas con el Señor, recomendadas por la Diócesis, este fin de semana. Tenemos exposición dos veces por semana: en Español los Martes por la noche, al final de la misa de las 6:30 p.m., y en Inglés los Jueves por la mañana, después de la misa de las 8:30 a.m.

También ofrecemos confesiones cinco veces por semana: los Lunes, Miércoles y Sábados por la mañana, después de la misa de las 8:30 a.m., y los Martes y Jueves por la noche, después de la misa de las 6:30 p.m.

En cuanto al amor al prójimo, contamos con nuestra Soc. de San Vicente de Paúl, muy activa y bien apoyada por la parroquia, que distribuye alimentos dos veces por semana (los Martes y Jueves por la mañana), y que lleva los alimentos a personas confinadas en sus hogares los Miércoles por la tarde, ofreciendo sus servicios tanto en inglés como en español. Y las distribuciones de los martes y jueves se han convertido en ocasiones para que diversas agencias vengan a informar sobre los servicios que ofrecen.

También hemos defendido y ayudado tanto a las personas sin hogar como a los inmigrantes.

Y hemos procurado brindar apoyo y ánimo a todos los grupos étnicos que tenemos en la parroquia, para que todos comprendan que somos hijos de Dios.

En este sentido, me alegra mucho que este año vayamos a celebrar una cena-baile de Halloween, a pesar de algunas objeciones de algunas de nuestras comunidades no anglosajonas, para destacar que Dios nos ama a todos y que los buenos recuerdos de todos nosotros, incluso de los que simplemente somos "de aquí", merecen ser celebrados.

Hemos sido una comunidad que espera destacar que todos somos amados tanto por Dios como por nuestra comunidad. ¡Que sigamos sirviendo al Señor y al prójimo de estas maneras!

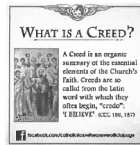

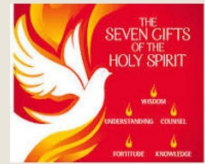

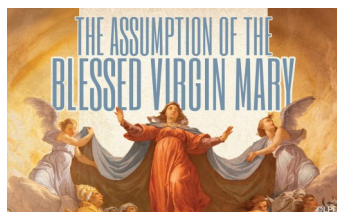
