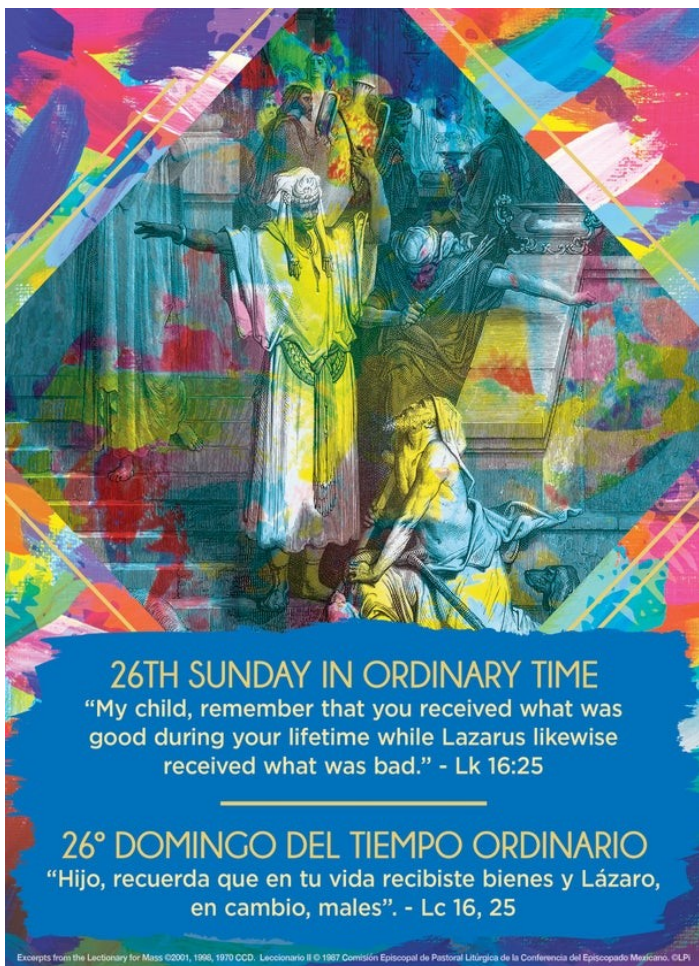

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

As promised the Readings progressively get harder this time of year.

In the First Reading, the Prophet Amos complains that the people of Zion were getting entirely too comfortable, enjoying their food, taking their rest, even “improvising” on the harp, playing tunes to themselves. He warns that they will be the first to be forced into exile (slavery) when the city falls.

In the Gospel Reading, Luke presents Jesus giving us this very uncomfortable parable of the rich man spending his life avoiding, walking around, perhaps even walking over the poor man Lazarus sitting at his gate.

Anyone who has experience with dealing with people who are homeless, and we do here at St. Philip’s know the challenge.

But all kinds of saints tell us that the poor and afflicted that we meet are actually invitations to us to get out of ourselves and show kindness.

Yes, others can be annoying. The existentialist (and yes, atheist) philosopher Jean-Paul Sartre even declared: “Hell is other people!”

But those others who annoy us remind us that we are not “Gods onto ourselves.” At minimum, we share the world with our other brothers and sisters, and all of us creations, children of the True God of the Universe.

And yet it may be hard to drop everything, immediately, to attend to the needs of someone who appears to right there, in front us, in need of help. What to do?

Above all, we’re called to be humble. To recognize that, indeed, none of us is God, that sometimes, despite our best hopes, we’re going to fail.

But we can, (1) always, pray for the person, (2) ask that the person come back later, or (3) quickly offer another plan, yes, _at times_ directing the person to someone else. All of this can be frustrating or disappointing to us.

Yet, we are asked not to give up, and just step over the person in need. St. Paul tells us: “Never tire of doing what is right.” (Gal 6:9).

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos Feligreses,

Como les advertí, las lecturas se vuelven cada vez más difíciles en este parte del año.

En la primera lectura, el profeta Amós se queja de que el pueblo de Sión se llega flojo, disfrutando de la comida, descansando, “canturreando con el arpa, tocando melodías simplemente para sí mismos. Advierte que serán los primeros en ser forzados al exilio (esclavitud) cuando la ciudad caiga.

En el Evangelio, Lucas nos presenta a Jesús con la incómoda parábola del hombre rico que se pasa la vida evitando, rodeando e incluso atropellando al pobre Lázaro, sentado a su puerta.

Cualquiera que tenga experiencia tratando con personas sin hogar, y nosotros aquí en San Felipe, conocemos el desafío.

Pero todo tipo de santos nos dicen que los pobres y afligidos que encontramos son en realidad invitaciones a salir más allá de nosotros mismos y mostrar bondad.

Sí, los demás pueden molestarnos. El filósofo existencialista (y sí, ateo) Jean-Paul Sartre llegó a declarar que los demás son infernales.

Pero esos otros que nos molestan nos recuerdan que no somos "dioses de nosotros mismos". Como mínimo, compartimos el mundo con nuestros hermanos y hermanas, y todos somos creaciones, hijos del Dios Verdadero del Universo.

Y, sin embargo, puede ser difícil dejarlo todo de inmediato para atender las necesidades de alguien que parece estar ahí, frente a nosotros, necesitando ayuda. ¿Qué hacer?

Sobre todo, estamos llamados a la humildad. A reconocer que, en efecto, ninguno de nosotros es Dios, que a veces, a pesar de nuestras mejores esperanzas, vamos a fracasar.

Pero podemos: (1) siempre, orar por la persona, (2) pedirle que regrese más tarde, o (3) ofrecerle rápidamente otro plan, sí, a veces, dirigiéndola a otra persona. Todo esto puede ser frustrante o decepcionante.

Sin embargo, se nos pide que no nos rindamos y que simplemente pasemos por encima de la persona necesitada. San Pablo nos pide que: «hagamos el bien sin desanimarnos.» (Gal 6,9).

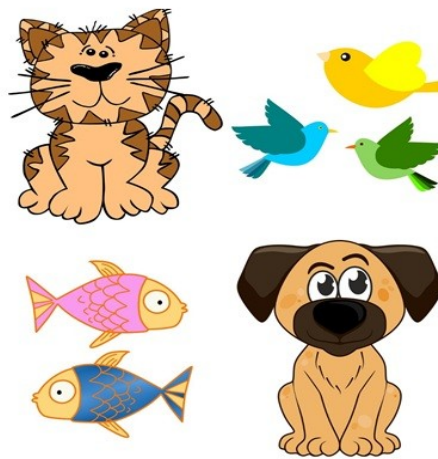
