Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Twenty-Seventh Sunday of Ordinary Time. We've also entered into the month of October, which the Church has celebrated as the Month of the Rosary.

I mention both because while our salvation came from God's only begotten Son, the Second Person of the Most Holy Trinity, the Word, who by the opening verses of John's Gospel was with God, and was God, Jesus entered into the world through the Consent of his human Mother Mary. Further, Mary became his first and most perfect Disciple.

So Mary has had a unique place in the life of the Church and of course as a Marian Order, within proper limits, we'd like to underline this.

We had quite an uneasy September in our country. It doesn't necessarily seem that this will change much in the coming months as every day seems to bring something new.

As a result, I'd like it, as we do pray the Rosary this month, be it as part of the various opportunities that we offer here, before and after Masses, during the day or in the evenings, or with your own groups, or simply at home, that we pray it for the intention of Peace, peace in both our world and in our hearts.

We do not know what the coming months and years may bring. But we know by faith that God is with us through it all. And honestly, over the years, I've found that the Rosary or even just praying a few Hail Mary's in times of stress (or distress) can be useful. This is a life skill that could help us in any number of situations in the years to come.

The Readings, especially the First Reading remind us of disconcerting times. The Gospel this Sunday, interestingly, has Jesus reminding us that we shouldn't expect special treatment for simply doing our job, for the right thing. But nevertheless we are assured that God is not blind and protects all of us in time of need.

Happy 27th Sunday of Ordinary Time, and Happy Month of the Rosary. May our prayers become a blessing and protection for us all,

Please Bring your Bible and Rosaries to be blessed during mass.



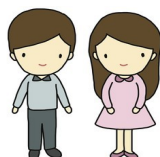
