PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

The Readings today remind us of the importance of others in our lives as well as the value of persistence in our struggles to achieve justice.

In the First Reading, the People of Israel found themselves in a battle against an Indigenous people named the Amelek.

Out in the Desert we are led to understand that this battle was one of truly "life and death."

So it was that Moses, the leader for the Israelites climbed up onto a hill to oversee the battle below, and we are told that so long as his arms were raised in blessing, the battle went well for the Israelites below. However, as soon as his arms started to drop, the battle turned and began to go badly for Israelites. Since the battle was a long and arduous one, several attending Israelites came "to support" Moses' arms, so that he could continue to hold them up, and victory would then be theirs.

How many times do we need similar support to continue in our work even when we too fall to exhaustion?

In the Gospel Reading we're given another kind of persistence: A widow before an unjust but powerful judge wears him down with her persistence. Even if he had no interest in "getting involved," he does so, just to eventually "get her off his back."

How many times do we face that kind of situation as well, where we need the help of someone who isn't necessarily keen to give it to us, but with persistence we convince that person that "everyone would be happier" if the person just went along and gave us the help that we needed.

In life, certainly Christian life, no one is an island, we need each other. Let us appreciate that and do what we can to help one other or at least not make this world harder for anyone. For we are all God's beloved children, everyone!

Queridos Feligreses,

Las lecturas de hoy nos recuerdan la importancia de los demás en nuestras vidas, así como el valor de la perseverancia en nuestra lucha por la justicia.

En la primera lectura, el pueblo de Israel se encontraba en una batalla contra un pueblo indígena llamado Amelec.

Encontrándose en el desierto, comprendemos que esta batalla era una batalla de vida o muerte.

Así, Moisés, el líder de los Israelitas, subió a una colina para supervisar la batalla, y se nos dice que mientras sus brazos estuvieran en alto en señal de bendición, la batalla iría bien para los Israelitas. Pero en cuanto sus brazos comenzaron a bajar, la batalla se tornó y empezó a ir mal para los Israelitas. Dado que la batalla fue larga y ardua, varios Israelitas presentes acudieron a apoyar los brazos de Moisés para que pudiera seguir sosteniéndolos y así obtener la victoria.

¿Cuántas veces necesitamos un apoyo similar para continuar en nuestra labor, incluso cuando nosotros también caemos exhaustos?

En el Evangelio se nos presenta otro tipo de persistencia: una viuda ante un juez injusto pero poderoso lo agota con su insistencia. Aunque no tuviera interés en involucrarse, lo hace, solo para finalmente quitársela de encima.

¿Cuántas veces nos encontramos en situaciones similares? Necesitamos la ayuda de alguien que no está necesariamente dispuesto a dárnosla, pero con perseverancia la convencemos de que todos serían más felices si simplemente nos ayudara.

En la vida, y en especial en la vida Cristiana, nadie es aislado; nos necesitamos unos a otros. Apreciamos esto y hagamos lo posible por ayudarnos mutuamente o, al menos, por no hacerles este mundo más difícil a nadie. ¡Porque todos somos hijos amados de Dios!

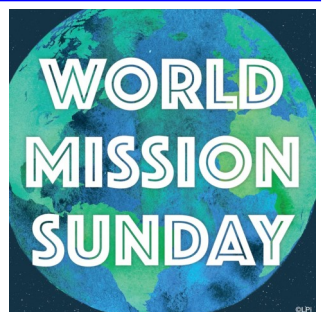
