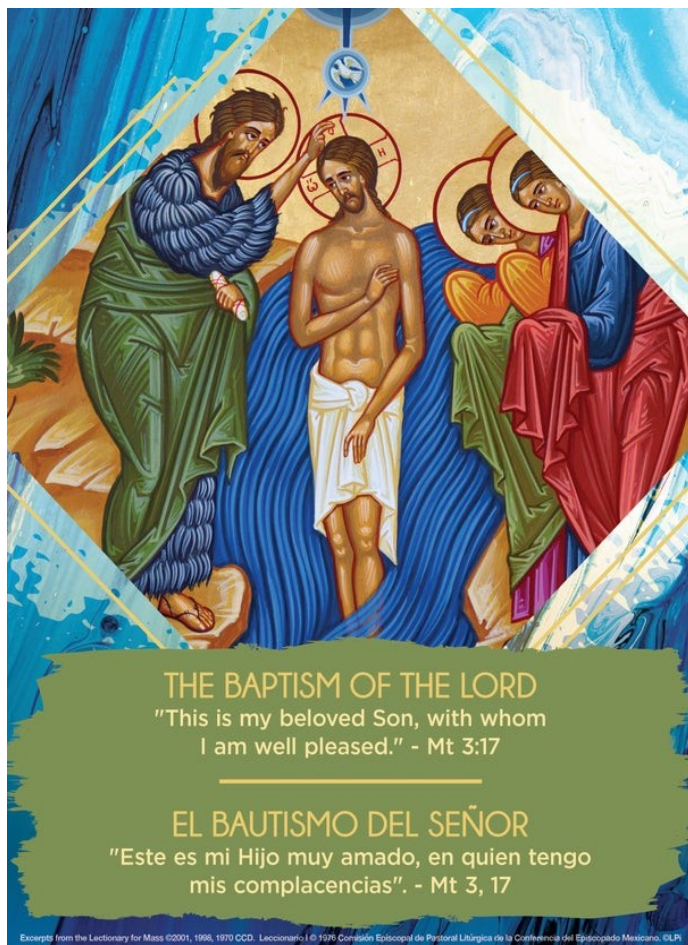

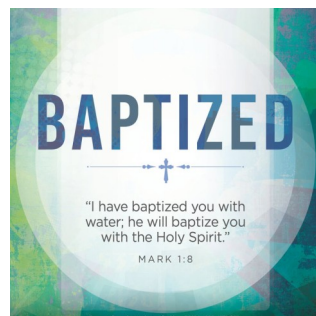

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

Today we celebrate the last day of Christmas, the annual Season in which we are invited to reflect on the Mystery of the Incarnation, that God, the Son, the Second Person of the Most Holy Trinity, existing for all eternity outside of the Universe that he himself created, in the fullness of time decided to enter into our world and become "one of us."

During the first Octave of Christmas, we reflected on Jesus' humanity – that "just like us" he entered into the world as a baby, in the context of a family, and with a human mother.

During the second Octave of Christmas, that of the Epiphany, we have been invited to reflect on Jesus' Divinity, that though he was "like us", he was also clearly "more than us."

That "Epiphany" began slowly – last Sunday, we heard that pretty much only three wisemen, magi, were able to discern that "something was different" in the heavens as a result of Jesus' birth. Pretty much everybody else, including Herod and the High Priests in Jerusalem, pointedly had seen "nothing out of the ordinary." And clearly our own births, did not produce "a disturbance" in the universe. Jesus' apparently did.

Then during the whole week that followed, we heard in the Gospel Readings one account after another, indicating that Jesus was special, clearly more than the average human being. We hear of him healing the sick, feeding the multitudes with only a few loaves of bread, walking on water, etc.

Finally, today we remember the circumstances of Jesus' baptism in the Jordan and we have to agree that the sky did not open on our Baptism, the Spirit of the Lord did not descent on us as a dove, and no voice was heard from the Heavens saying to all: "This is my beloved child with whom I am well pleased." This happened to Jesus.

So let us give thanks for God sending his Son among us, and appreciate the level of concern that God has had for each and everyone of us!

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos Feligreses:

Hoy celebramos el último día de Navidad, la temporada anual en la que se nos invita a reflexionar sobre el Misterio de la Encarnación, que Dios, el Hijo, la Segunda Persona de la Santísima Trinidad, quien ya existía por toda la eternidad más allá del universo que Él mismo ha creado, en la plenitud de los tiempos decidió entrar en nuestro mundo y encarnarse como "uno de nosotros".

Durante la primera Octava de Navidad, hemos reflexionado sobre la humanidad de Jesús: que, "como todos nosotros", entró en el mundo como un bebé, en el seno de una familia y con una madre humana.

Durante la segunda Octava de Navidad, la de la Epifanía, se nos ha invitado a reflexionar sobre la Divinidad de Jesús, que, aunque era "como nosotros", también era "más que nosotros".

Esa "Epifanía" comenzó gradualmente: el Domingo pasado, escuchamos que prácticamente solo tres personas, los Reyes Magos, discernieron que "algo era diferente" en los cielos como resultado del nacimiento de Jesús. Prácticamente todos los demás, incluyendo a Herodes y a los sumos sacerdotes en Jerusalén, no habían visto "nada fuera de lo común". E claramente nuestros nacimientos no produjeron "una perturbación" en el universo. El de Jesús, aparentemente, sí.

Luego, durante toda la semana siguiente, escuchamos en las lecturas del Evangelio un relato tras otro, que indicaban que Jesús era especial, claramente más que un ser humano. Oímos hablar de cómo sanaba a los enfermos, alimentaba a las multitudes con solo unos pocos panes, caminaba sobre el agua, etc.

Finalmente, hoy recordamos las circunstancias del bautismo de Jesús en el Jordán y tenemos que reconocer que el cielo no se abrió en nuestro bautismo, el Espíritu del Señor no descendió sobre nosotros como una paloma, y no se oyó ninguna voz del cielo que dijera a todos: "Este es mi Hijo amado, en quien tengo mis complacencias". Esto le sucedió a Jesús.

Así que demos gracias a Dios por enviar a su Hijo entre nosotros, y apreciemos el gran amor que Dios tiene por cada uno de nosotros.

¡Feliz último día de Navidad!

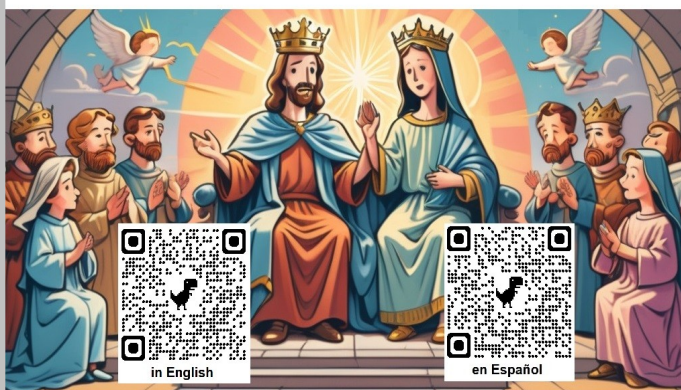
