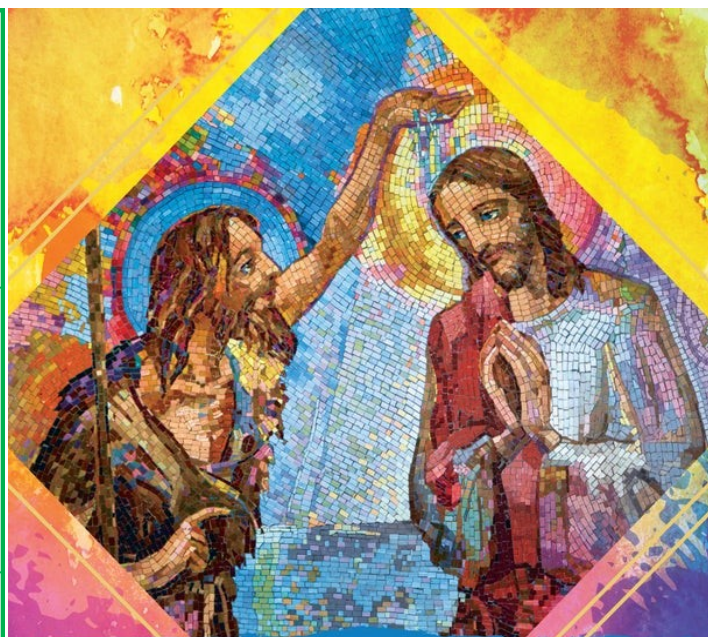

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

After a lovely celebration of Advent and then the Christmas Seasons, we find ourselves for a short period of Ordinary Time.

Actually, this Sunday, the Second Sunday of Ordinary Time still carries with it a (fainter) echo of last Sunday's celebration of the Baptism of the Lord.

And indeed there were times in the history of the Church when the "Christmas Cycle" sometimes called "Christmas Tide" was seen as only ending 40 days after Jesus' birth with the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord (Candle Mass) on February 2nd. That custom would mirror "Easter Tide" or the Easter Season which concludes 50 days after the Resurrection with Pentecost.

The shortest version of the Christmas Season would have been "The Twelve Days of Christmas" which extended from the Feast of the Nativity of the Lord on Dec 25th to the Feast of the Epiphany (or Three Kings) on January 6th.

Sometimes BOTH the "Twelve Days of Christmas" and "Christmas Tide" extending 40 days to the Feast of the Presentation on February 2nd were observed.

The various traditions are all lovely and serve to underline the fascination that people have had with the Christmas Season's central mystery, that God, would have deigned to come down from the heavens, to walk with, and be, one of us.

And perhaps it is worthwhile to still spend a few more weeks -- even as we listen after this Sunday to the accounts of the beginnings of Jesus' mystery -- reflecting on the marvel of it all, that God would be so interested in us and the otherwise workings of his creation.

The Gospel that we hear today is a gentler version of the far more dramatic Baptism of the Lord that we heard last week, but it helps us to still appreciate the care that God has for the world he created, and invites us to care similarly for the brothers and sisters and all the rest of creation around us.

May we continue to appreciate all that we have received from the Lord.

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Estimados Feligreses:

Después de una hermosa celebración del Adviento y de la Navidad, nos encontramos en un breve período del Tiempo Ordinario.

De hecho, este Domingo, el Segundo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, aún conserva un eco (si más suave) de la celebración del Bautismo del Señor del Domingo pasado.

Y, en efecto, hubo épocas en la historia de la Iglesia en las que el "Ciclo de Navidad", se consideraba que terminaba 40 días después del nacimiento de Jesús, con la Fiesta de la Presentación del Señor (la Candelaria) el 2 de Febrero. Esta costumbre reflejaba el "Tiempo Pascual," que concluye 50 días después de la Resurrección con Pentecostés.

La versión más corta de la Temporada de Navidad era la de los "Doce Días de Navidad", que se extendía desde la Fiesta de la Natividad del Señor el 25 de Diciembre hasta la Fiesta de la Epifanía (o de los Reyes Magos) el 6 de Enero.

A veces se observaban tanto los "Doce Días de Navidad" como el "Tiempo de Navidad", que se extendía 40 días hasta la Fiesta de la Presentación el 2 de Febrero.

Todas estas tradiciones son hermosas y sirven para destacar la fascinación que la gente ha sentido por el misterio central de la Navidad: que Dios se dignara a descender de los cielos, a caminar entre nosotros y a ser uno de nosotros.

Y quizás valga la pena dedicar algunas semanas más — incluso mientras escuchamos, después de este Domingo, los relatos de los inicios del misterio de Jesús— a reflexionar sobre la maravilla de todo esto: que Dios esté tan interesado en nosotros y en el funcionamiento de su creación.

El Evangelio que escuchamos hoy es una versión más serena del Bautismo del Señor que escuchamos la semana pasada, pero nos ayuda a apreciar el cuidado que Dios tiene por el mundo que creó, y nos invita a cuidar de manera similar a nuestros hermanos y hermanas y a toda la creación que nos rodea.

Que sigamos apreciando todo lo que hemos recibido del Señor.

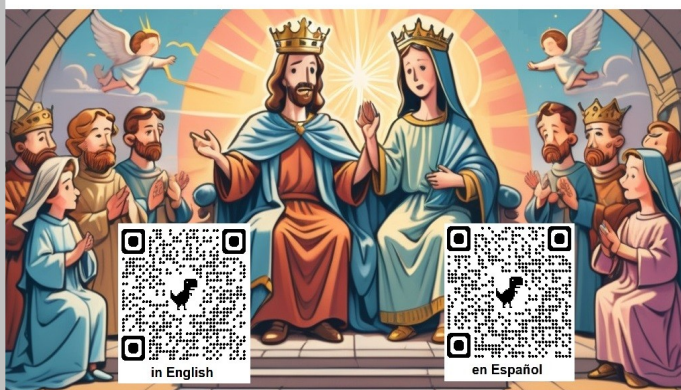
