PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

As occasionally happens, an important Feast or Commemoration falls on a Sunday of Ordinary Time. So instead of celebrating the XXXI Sunday of Ordinary time, this Sunday, Nov 2, we are celebrating the Commemoration of All Souls instead.

This Commemoration asks us to pray for all our loved ones / faithful departed, reminding us of God's Mercy and of Jesus' Mission that he "not lose anyone" who was entrusted to him by The Father.

We recognize first that generally none of us have lived "our best lives," that all of us have fallen short, that is, sinned. Yet we also recognize God's Mercy for the souls of our loved ones (we are all God's creations) that perhaps proved to not be not perfect, and perhaps even failed a lot, but really didn't / don't deserve to be condemned for all eternity.

It was C.S. Lewis' insight that even Hell (at least if understood as eternal separation from God) exists out of God's mercy "for those who belong there." If one really doesn't like people and doesn't like to pray, then Heaven could really be far worse a place than Hell ...

So if even Hell exists out of God's mercy, then a place which we traditionally call Purgatory would exist as well, for those who don't necessarily belong in Heaven (yet) but don't deserve to be in Hell either.

Then praying for our faithful departed also reminds us of our proper place in God's creative plan. Our presence here on earth is not eternal, our destiny is to move on from here, hopefully to God.

Indeed, since traditionally we visit our loved ones at the cemetery on this day, I'd like to end recalling an epitaph carved in a tombstone near where my family is buried that apparently always drove my paternal grandfather crazy.

It reads: "Who you are, we once were. Who we are, you'll one day be." None of us is eternal, here. Our destiny is with God.

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos Feligreses:

Como ocurre ocasionalmente, una fiesta o conmemoración importante coincide con un Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario. Por lo tanto, en lugar de celebrar el XXXI Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, este domingo el 2 de noviembre celebraremos la Conmemoración de Todos los Fieles Difuntos.

Esta conmemoración nos invita a orar por todos nuestros seres queridos y fieles difuntos, recordándonos la misericordia de Dios y la misión de Jesús de "no perder a ninguno" de los que le fueron confiados por el Padre.

Reconocemos, en primer lugar, que generalmente ninguno de nosotros ha vivido "una vida perfecta", que todos hemos caído a veces, es decir, hemos pecado. Sin embargo, también reconocemos la misericordia de Dios para con las almas de nuestros seres queridos (todos somos creación de Dios) que quizás no fueron perfectos, e pudieron haber fallado mucho, pero que realmente no merecen ser condenados por toda la eternidad.

C.S. Lewis sostenía que incluso el Infierno (al menos si se entiende como la separación eterna de Dios) existe por la misericordia de Dios "para aquellos que pertenecen allí". Si a uno realmente no le gustan las personas y no le gusta orar, el Cielo podría ser un lugar mucho peor que el Infierno...

Así que, si incluso el Infierno existe por la misericordia de Dios, entonces también existiría un lugar que tradicionalmente llamamos Purgatorio, para aquellos que no necesariamente pertenecen al Cielo (todavía) pero que tampoco merecen estar en el Infierno.

Orar por nuestros fieles difuntos también nos recuerda de nuestro lugar en el plan creador de Dios. Nuestra presencia aquí en la tierra no es eterna; nuestro destino es partir de aquí, con la esperanza de ir a Dios.

De hecho, dado que tradicionalmente visitamos a nuestros seres queridos en el cementerio en este día, me gustaría terminar recordando un epitafio grabado en una lápida cerca de donde está enterrada mi familia, que aparentemente siempre exasperaba a mi abuelo paterno.

Dice: "Quienes son Uds, fuimos también. Quienes somos, serán Uds. también". Ninguno de nosotros es eterno aquí. Nuestro destino está con Dios.

First Holy Communion Rite of Enrollment Mass**What is the Communion Rite of Enrollment?**

The Rite of Enrollment is for those children and their parents who are entering the second year preparation period for First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion.

This Rite of Enrollment ceremony marks the beginning of a “journey of faith” for children and their parents who are starting the sacramental formation process. It is also a sign to the larger community that all of us have a role in the formation of everyone in the parish.

Likewise, it shows children and their families that they are part of the larger faith community. The members of the parish community provide prayer and support which is needed for the children, their families, and their catechists throughout the formation period.

Through the commitment card, the communion candidates ask their families, teachers, catechists, classmates and the parish community to help them prepare to receive the Sacraments.

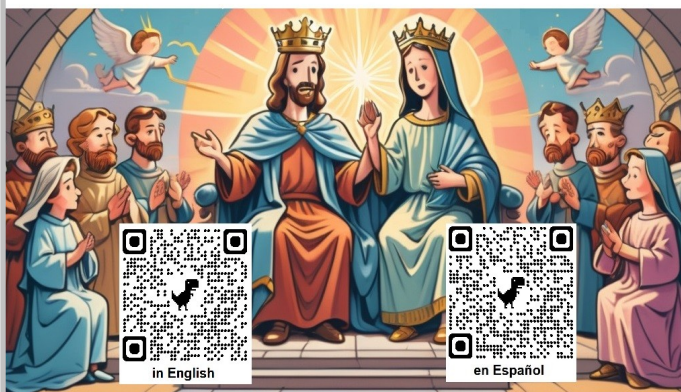
