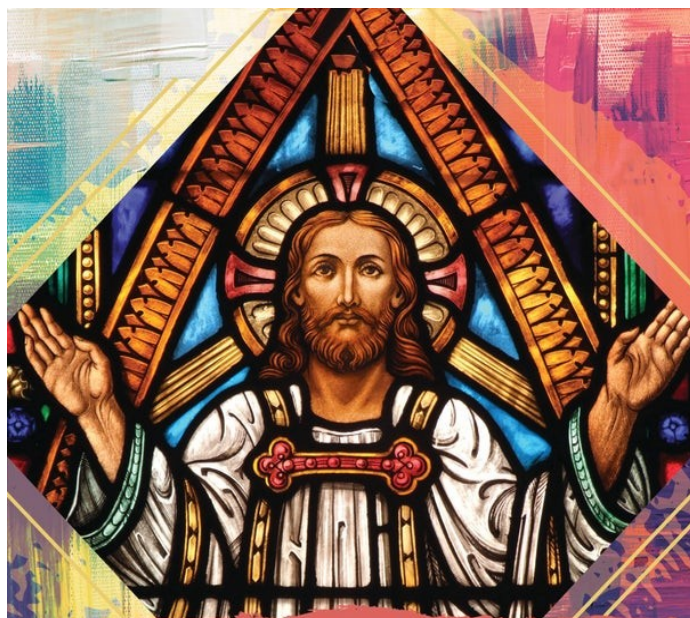

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

First, greetings from the Servite General Chapter at the Casa Divin Maestro Conference Center across Lake Albino from Castell Gandolfo outside of Rome. Yes, it's lovely and thankfully still not raining, though I'm beginning to think that my memory from seminary days of it raining near all the time in Rome in November may be something of a "colored by time" exaggeration!

Our Spirituality Day at the beginning of this meeting was wonderful, reminding us all that as members of a religious order founded by Seven Holy Founders and all under the Mary's protective mantle, we are called to see in "difference" a potential blessing (an opportunity to become more than we were before) rather than a problem to try to put down. These are truly lovely words for an Order, small but diverse, with fifty different smiles on the faces of the delegates here with a true spectrum of skin-tones, languages and accents. What a joy it is to be part of it!

But to the purpose here. We find ourselves celebrating the 33rd Sunday of Ordinary Time, the Sunday before we celebrate the Feast of Christ the King and with it bring the Liturgical Year to an end.

These weeks, the Readings remind us of Endings and of Judgement. Today we hear Jesus telling the Apostles that of the Jerusalem Temple, not a stone will be left on top of another stone and so not to put our ultimate hopes into human projects even ones sincerely dedicated to God.

The Church may have something to say about that as we are a both human and divine project (together we form the Body of Christ and we are animated by the Holy Spirit). Still as "living stones" and animated by said "Holy Spirit" which necessarily blows where it wills, we are called to be humble. Certainties of today, let alone yesterday, can blow away tomorrow.

That said, we are assured that Jesus will be with us through it all. "Heaven and Earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away," (Mt 24:35, Mk 13:31, Lk 21:33) "And know that I am with you until the end of the age" (Mt 28:20). These should be hopeful words to us at any time of difficulty and crisis).

So no matter how much rain comes, no matter what crisis may befall any or all of us, with Jesus with can make it safely to the other side. "Ain't no mountain high enough, ain't no valley deep enough ..." God bless you all,

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Estimados Feligreses:

En primer lugar, les envío un saludo desde el Capítulo General de los Siervos de María que celebramos en el Centro de la Casa del Divin Maestro, al otro lado del lago Albano, cerca de Castel Gandolfo, a la periferia de Roma. Sí, es un lugar precioso y, afortunadamente, todavía no llueve, aunque empiezo a pensar que mi memoria de los días del seminario, de que llovía casi todo el tiempo en Roma en Noviembre, ¡quizás sea una exageración!

Nuestro Día de Espiritualidad al comienzo de esta reunión fue maravilloso, recordándonos a todos que, como miembros de una orden religiosa fundada por Siete Santos Fundadores y bajo el manto protector de María, estamos llamados a ver en la "diferencia" una posible bendición (una oportunidad para crecer aprender algo nuevo) en lugar de un problema para borrar. Estas son palabras maravillosas para una Orden, pequeña pero diversa, con cincuenta sonrisas diferentes en los rostros de los delegados aquí presentes, colorados de una verdadera variedad de tonos de piel, idiomas y acentos. ¡Qué alegría es hacer parte de este convenio!

Pero vayamos al tema que nos ocupa aquí. Nos encontramos celebrando el 33^o Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, el Domingo anterior a la celebración de la Fiesta de Cristo Rey, con la que finaliza el Año Litúrgico.

Estas semanas, las Lecturas nos recuerdan los Finales y el Juicio. Hoy escuchamos a Jesús decir a los Apóstoles que del Templo de Jerusalén no quedará piedra sobre piedra, y que, por lo tanto, no debemos poner nuestras esperanzas en proyectos humanos, ni siquiera en aquellos sinceramente dedicados a Dios.

La Iglesia quizás tenga algo que decir al respecto, ya que hacemos todos partes de un proyecto tanto humano como divino (juntos formamos el Cuerpo de Cristo y estamos animados por el Espíritu Santo). Aun así, como "piedras vivas" y animados por dicho "Espíritu Santo", que sopla donde quiere, estamos llamados a ser humildes. Las certezas de hoy, y mucho menos las de ayer, pueden desvanecerse mañana.

Dicho esto, tenemos la seguridad de que Jesús estará con nosotros a través de todo. "El cielo y la tierra pasarán, pero mis palabras no pasarán" (Mt 24:35, Mc 13:31, Lc 21:33). "Y sepan que yo estoy con ustedes todos los días, hasta el fin del mundo" (Mt 28:20). Estas deben ser palabras de esperanza para nosotros en cualquier momento de dificultad y crisis.

Así que, por mucha lluvia que caiga, por mucha crisis que nos sobrevenga a cualquiera o a todos, con Jesús podemos llegar sanos y salvos al otro lado. "No hay montaña tan alta, ni valle tan profundo..." Que Dios los bendiga a todos,

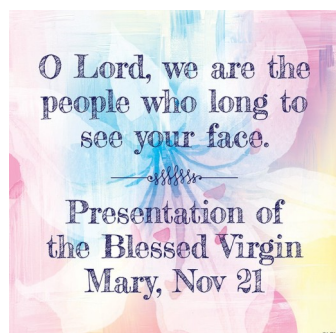
