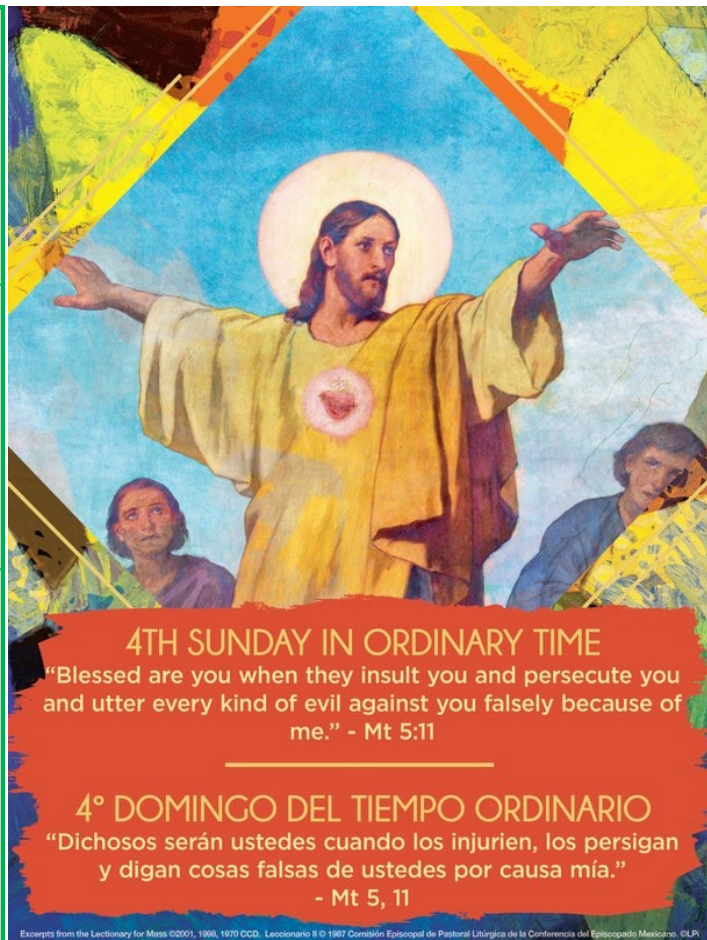

**PASTORS PONDERINGS**

Dear Parishioners,

The Gospel that we are following this year (A) at our Sunday Masses is that of Matthew.

This Sunday we begin a several Sunday look at Jesus' Sermon on the Mount as presented by St. Matthew, beginning of course with the Beatitudes.

Additionally, as both the Feast of the Seven Holy Founders (which we'll be celebrating on the weekend of Feb 14-15<sup>th</sup>) and Ash Wednesday, which will fall on February 18<sup>th</sup>, loom near, we will be conducting our Pastoral Services Appeal this weekend.

This means "less of a homily" as we focus on the PSA. However, (1) most of us would know the beginning of the Sermon on the Mount, with Jesus' Beatitudes proclaimed ("Blessed are they, who ..."), a Homily on the Beatitudes would be less "instructive" and more "reflective" anyway, and (2) having our conducting of the PSA on the Sunday of the Beatitudes also reminds us of what the Church ought to be: Is it welcoming to the downtrodden ("poor in spirit"), the sorrowing, the humble, those who hunger and thirst for righteousness? Is it merciful? Does it protect the innocent? Do the persecuted or simply maligned feel that they have a home here? And do we support and protect those who've in any number of ways "stuck out their necks" for the sake of Gospel?

A good part of the PSA is about helping the Church full, both at our parish and beyond, support the missions above.

So honestly, how are we doing? How can we do better? And even if we're not doing altogether great with regard to some of those beatitudes above, again, both here and in the larger Diocese, can you still support us, so that we can do better in the years to come?

Our Gospel is awesome, our Gospel gives hope to all kinds of people all across the world. And Jesus was certainly right in saying: "The harvest is plenty, laborers few." We all need to enter fields or even just support those who are already there, to bring the harvest home. God bless you all, and please help support the PSA so that we can do so in our corner of the Kingdom of God,

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Estimados Feligreses:

El Evangelio que seguimos este año (Ciclo A) en nuestras misas Dominicales es el de San Mateo.

Este Domingo comenzamos una serie de Domingos dedicados al Sermón de la Montaña de Jesús, según lo que presenta San Mateo, comenzando, naturalmente, con las Bienaventuranzas.

Además, dado que se acercan la Fiesta de los Siete Santos Fundadores (que celebraremos el fin de semana del 14 y 15 de Febrero) y el Miércoles de Ceniza, que será el 18 de febrero, buscamos a realizar nuestra Campaña de Servicios Pastorales (P.S.A.) este fin de semana.

Esto significa que la homilía será más breve, ya que nos centraremos en la Campaña. Sin embargo, (1) la mayoría de nosotros conocemos el comienzo del Sermón de la Montaña, con las Bienaventuranzas proclamadas por Jesús («Benditos los que...»), por lo que una homilía sobre las Bienaventuranzas sería en cualquier caso menos instructiva y más reflexiva; y (2) realizar la Campaña de Servicios Pastorales el domingo de las Bienaventuranzas nos recuerda lo que la Iglesia debe ser: ¿Es acogedora con los fatigados («los pobres de espíritu»), los afligidos, los humildes, los que tienen hambre y sed de justicia? ¿Es misericordiosa? ¿Protege a los inocentes? ¿Se sienten acogidos aquí los perseguidos y los simplemente calumniados? ¿Apoyamos y protegemos a quienes, de diversas maneras, se han arriesgado por el Evangelio?

Gran parte de la Campaña de Servicios Pastorales se trata de ayudar a la Iglesia, tanto en nuestra parroquia como en la Diócesis más larga, a apoyar las misiones mencionadas.

Así que, sinceramente, ¿cómo estamos? ¿Cómo podemos mejorar? E incluso si no nos va del todo bien con respecto a algunas de estas bienaventuranzas, tanto aquí como en la diócesis en general, ¿pueden seguir apoyándonos para que podamos mejorar en los próximos años?

Nuestro Evangelio es maravilloso, nuestro Evangelio ofrece esperanza a todo tipo de personas en todo el mundo. Y Jesús tenía razón al decir: «La mies es grande, pero los obreros pocos». Todos necesitamos trabajar en los campos o simplemente apoyar a quienes ya están allí, para recoger la cosecha. Que Dios los bendiga a todos, favor, ayuden a apoyar la Campaña de Servicios Pastorales para que podamos hacer nuestro mejor en nuestra parte del Reino de Dios.

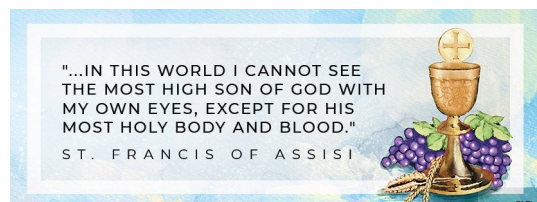

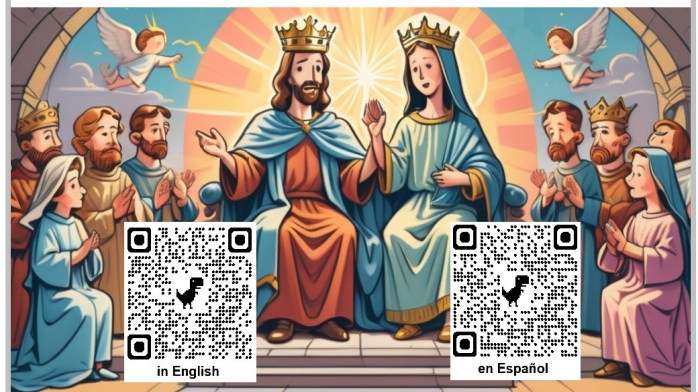
