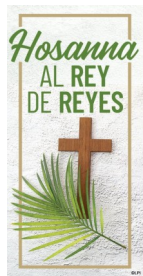

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

After five weeks of preparation we come to Palm Sunday, the beginning of Holy Week.

We've been asked to put aside, in as much as we can, our regular concerns (1st Sunday of Lent), gotten a glimpse of the future glory of Jesus assuring us that following him will be worth it (2nd Sunday). Then we spent three Sundays contemplating the ever larger scope of Jesus' redemptive mission, from Jesus reaching out to the socially marginalized (the Samaritan Woman of the 3rd Sunday of Lent) to those suffering great challenges from birth (the Man born blind of the 4th Sunday of Lent) to even those who were dead and (long) buried (5th Sunday of Lent), that Jesus' redemptive mission extends to everyone.

Today we begin our annual commemoration of how this mission was sealed – in Jesus' own blood.

We often wish to have predictable, comfortable lives. The unexpected often scares us. But if we wish to have control over everything, then ultimately we block-out the ability of even God being able to reach us.

When Jesus entered into Jerusalem, he certainly knew that "the Time had come." How it was going to play out, was perhaps, at least to his human nature not entirely certain (based on his prayers at Gethsemane) but he knew that it was going to be both painful and necessary. And yes, when his closest disciples, the Apostles, saw what was happening, we'll find that they all ran away.

They were scared, it was okay to be scared, it is okay to be scared, it all proved incredibly painful, but ultimately it turned out okay.

Holy Week ends well ... with the Resurrection on Easter Sunday.

So please don't worry. There are changes coming here at St. Philip Benizi, but they will turn out to be a blessing. New energy will be brought here, new ideas, new hopes, new dreams. And yes, they will fulfill the previous ones that we had. We have a God who can convert anything into Good.

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos Feligreses:

Tras cinco semanas de preparación, llegamos al Domingo de Ramos, el comienzo de la Semana Santa.

Se nos pidió dejar, en la medida de lo posible, nuestras preocupaciones habituales (1.er Domingo de Cuaresma); vimos si solo por un poco la gloria futura de Jesús, lo cual nos asegura que seguirlo valdrá la pena (2.º Domingo). Luego pasamos tres domingos contemplando el horizonte siempre más amplio de la misión redentora de Jesús: desde Jesús tendiendo la mano a los marginados socialmente (la mujer Samaritana del 3.er Domingo de Cuaresma), pasando por aquellos que sufren grandes desafíos desde su nacimiento (el ciego de nacimiento del 4.º Domingo de Cuaresma), hasta llegar incluso a aquellos que estaban muertos y por un bien tiempo sepultados (5.º Domingo de Cuaresma); todo ello demuestra que la misión redentora de Jesús se extiende realmente a todos.

Hoy comenzamos nuestra conmemoración anual de cómo esta misión fue sellada: con la propia sangre de Jesús.

A menudo deseamos tener vidas predecibles y cómodas. Lo inesperado suele asustarnos. Pero si deseamos tener el control sobre todo, bloqueemos aun la capacidad de Dios a entrar en nuestras vidas.

Cuando Jesús entró en Jerusalén, ciertamente sabía que «había llegado la Hora». Cómo se desarrollarían los acontecimientos era, tal vez —al menos para su naturaleza humana— algo incierto para (tomando en cuenta sus oraciones en Getsemaní); pero él sabía que sería, a la vez, doloroso pero necesario. Y sí, cuando sus discípulos más cercanos —los Apóstoles— vieron lo que estaba sucediendo, descubrimos que todos huyeron.

Estaban asustados; estaba bien tener miedo, está bien tener miedo. Todo lo que pasó fue increíblemente doloroso, pero, a fin de cuentas, todo salió bien.

La Semana Santa termina bien... con la Resurrección el Domingo de Pascua.

Así que, por favor, no se preocupen. Se avecinan cambios aquí en San Felipe Benizi, pero resultarán ser una bendición. Llegarán aquí nuevas energías, nuevas ideas, nuevas esperanzas, nuevos sueños. Y sí, darán cumplimiento a aquellos sueños y esperanzas que teníamos anteriormente. Tenemos un Dios capaz de convertir cualquier cosa en Bien.
