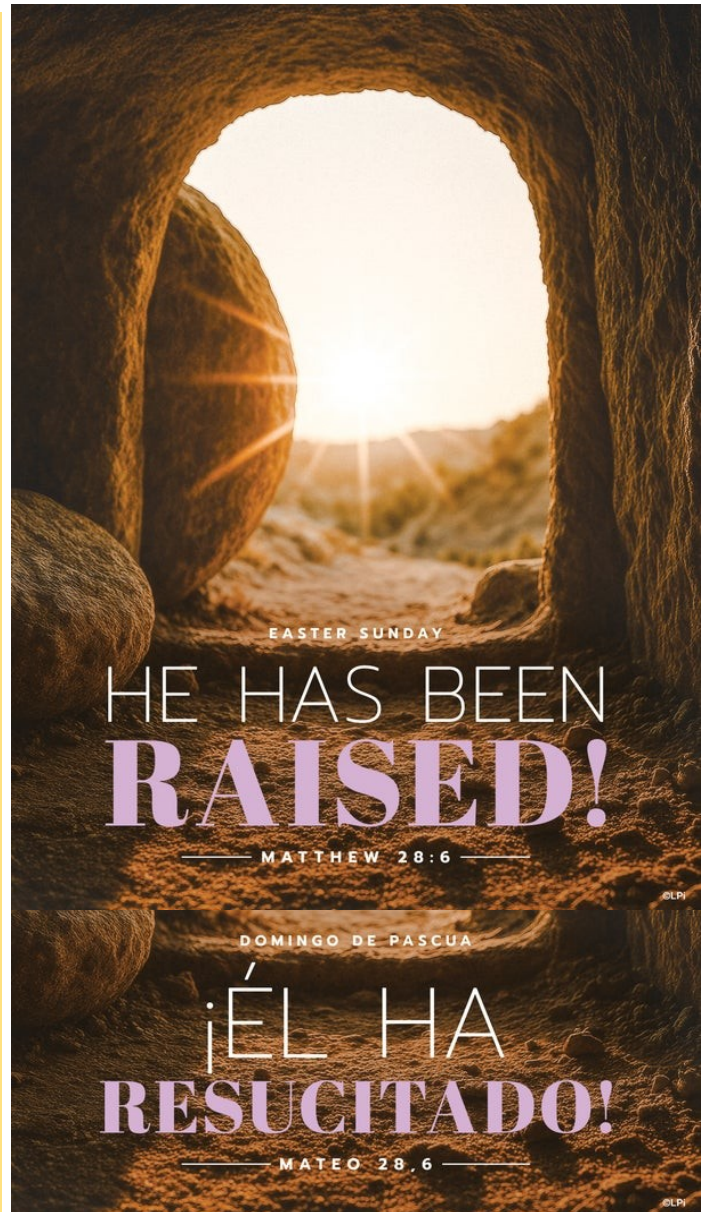

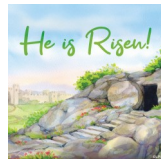

PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

With Easter (Resurrection of the Lord) Sunday, we conclude our annual celebration of Holy Week.

We give the most profound and sincerest thanks to our God the Father and to his Son for what the Son (Jesus) did for us, all of us – that he suffered and died for us, all of us, and then rose to assure us, all of us that life does not end in death but continues with God.

He is Risen! Alleluia!

The Readings, of course, that we hear during Holy Week and on Easter Sunday are not new to us. For the most part, we hear them every year.

What struck me this year, perhaps because Holy Week fell so close this year to the Feast of the Annunciation, was God's kindness, respect for women.

In the Annunciation account, God, who could have taken Mary however he wanted, sent an emissary to her, and her consent to the project proposed to her – her collaboration in the saving the whole world – was important. I honestly wonder if consent ought to play a bigger role in our understanding of conception, that the woman's consent to conception ought to be given a greater significance in our understanding of that most critical time in all of our lives.

At the other end of Jesus' earthly life, all four of the Gospels honor and remember Mary Magdalene's presence both at Jesus' crucifixion and then at the discovery of his Resurrection.

In my lifetime, much has been made (and sometimes unfairly inferred) from Mary Magdalene's closeness to Jesus and her presence in those most important moments of Jesus' journey.

However, after 27 years of priestly ministry, I can not but remain in awe of so many committed (!) women disciples in our parishes and communities. And I'm not talking about any romantic aspect to their involvement in the Church, rather simply a powerful witness and commitment to our common belief that Jesus Christ is Lord.

So on this Easter Sunday, let us remember the MANY committed women who make our parishes what they are. God bless you all! (God bless the men too, of course!) But so often, it's the women, like St. Mary Magdalene are there first, so often the last. Thank you and God bless you, and happy Easter to all!

PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Queridos feligreses:

Con el Domingo de Pascua (la Resurrección del Señor), concluimos nuestra celebración anual de la Semana Santa.

Damos las más profundas y sinceras gracias a nuestro Dios Padre y a su Hijo por lo que el Hijo (Jesús) hizo por nosotros, por todos nosotros: que sufrió y murió por nosotros, por todos nosotros; y luego resucitó para asegurarnos a todos nosotros, que la vida no termina con la muerte, sino que continúa junto a Dios.

¡Ha resucitado! ¡Aleluya!

Las lecturas, por supuesto, que escuchamos durante la Semana Santa y el Domingo de Pascua sabemos. En su mayor parte, las escuchamos cada año.

Lo que me llamó la atención este año —quizás porque la Semana Santa coincidió tan cerca de la Fiesta de la Anunciación— fue la bondad de Dios y su respeto hacia las mujeres.

En el relato de la Anunciación, Dios —quien podría hacer con María como hubiera querido— le envió un emisario; y el consentimiento de ella al proyecto que se le proponía —su colaboración en la salvación del mundo entero— fue fundamental. Sinceramente, me pregunto si el consentimiento de la mujer debería desempeñar un papel más relevante en nuestra comprensión de la concepción; si no se debería otorgar una mayor importancia al consentimiento de la mujer en nuestro entendimiento de esta temporada crucial en la vida de todos nosotros.

En el otro extremo de la vida terrenal de Jesús, todos los cuatro Evangelios honran y recuerdan la presencia de María Magdalena, tanto durante la crucifixión de Jesús como en el momento del descubrimiento de su Resurrección.

A lo largo de mi vida, se ha especulado mucho (y, en ocasiones, injustamente) sobre de la cercanía de María Magdalena a Jesús y de su presencia en esos momentos tan trascendentales del camino de él.

Pero tras veintisiete años de ministerio sacerdotal, no puedo sino seguir maravillándome ante la presencia de tantas mujeres discípulas —¡tan comprometidas!— en nuestras parroquias y comunidades. Y no me refiero aquí a ningún aspecto romántico en su participación dentro de la Iglesia, sino, en su testimonio poderoso y firme compromiso en nuestra fe común: que Jesucristo es el Señor.

Por ello, en este Domingo de Pascua, deseo honrar a las MUCHAS mujeres comprometidas que hacen de nuestras parroquias lo que son. ¡Que Dios las bendiga a todas! (¡Que Dios bendiga también a los hombres, por supuesto!) Pero tan a menudo son las mujeres —como Santa María Magdalena— quienes están allí primero; tan a menudo, las últimas. ¡Gracias y que Dios las bendiga, y feliz Pascua a todos!

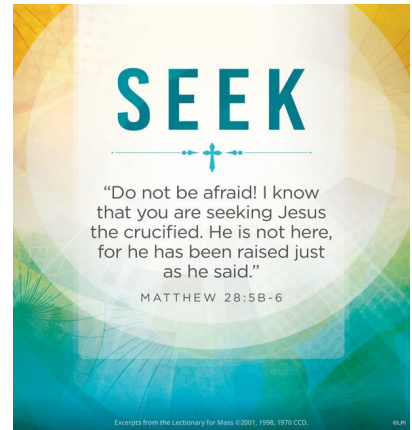

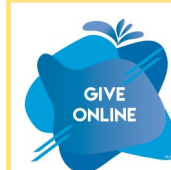

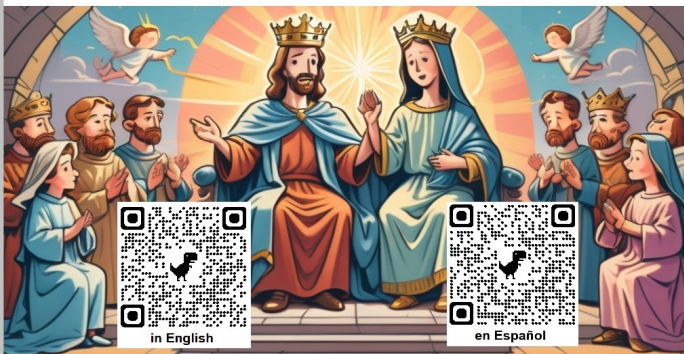
