PASTORS PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

We find ourselves now celebrating the Third Sunday of Easter, which is a “transitional Sunday” in this Season. The Gospel Reading is still about Jesus’ Resurrection, but is one from “late in the day” – about the two disciples encountering Jesus on the “Road to Emmaus.” Next Sunday, the Liturgy will take a turn, focusing on Jesus as the Good Shepherd.

The “Road to Emmaus” Reading is another beloved text. We’re hearing it for the third time during the season: It is the Gospel Reading to be used on the Evening of Easter Sunday. We hear it as one of the post-Resurrection Gospel Readings during the Octave of Easter, and we hear it today as well (next year, we will hear a different, though post-Resurrectionist Reading, but this year we hear it three times.

Further many a Retreats or Spiritual Direction Programs find their inspiration in this Reading, as it talks about a process – the two disciples already talking about Jesus when he joins them, Jesus then explaining the Scriptures to them, and their finally, definitively recognizing him in their lives at the “breaking of bread,” that is to say at the Eucharist.

Since life itself is a journey, the episode invites us to reflect on our own lives, and some of the more dramatic ones in them, and to seek, if simply “looking back” (as the disciples did) God’s / Jesus’ presence in them.

We too, all of us find ourselves facing a new journey. We aren’t necessarily embarking yet. Indeed, there’s a fair amount of packing, set things in order, and saying goodbye, celebrating and even some crying to do beforehand.

But a new journey, a new chapter in our lives of faith is awaiting us all.

What we can however be certain is that God in Jesus will be with us, walking with us as new adventures, new experiences and new insights await. Yes, all this can initially be scary. But with God with us, all will turn out well.

God bless you all, and may we come to appreciate the new things that God has prepared for us. Happy Third Sunday of Easter!

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Queridos feligreses:

Nos encontramos ahora celebrando el Tercer Domingo de Pascua, el cual se puede entender como un «domingo de transición» dentro de este tiempo litúrgico. La lectura del Evangelio sigue versando sobre la Resurrección de Jesús, pero se trata de un pasaje que pasa «al caer la tarde» tratando el encuentro de los dos discípulos con Jesús en el «Camino de Emaús». El próximo domingo, la liturgia dará un giro para centrarse en Jesús como el Buen Pastor.

El pasaje del «Camino de Emaús» es un texto bien querido. Lo escuchamos por tercera vez durante esta temporada: la escuchamos por primera vez en la tarde del Domingo de Pascua; lo escuchamos otra vez como una de las lecturas evangélicas en los días siguientes durante la Octava de Pascua, y lo escuchamos también hoy (el próximo año escucharemos una lectura diferente —aunque también posterior a la Resurrección—, pero este año este pasaje escuchamos tres veces).

Además, numerosos retiros espirituales y programas de dirección espiritual toman su inspiración en esta lectura, ya que esta describe un proceso: los dos discípulos conversando ya sobre Jesús cuando Él se une a ellos; Jesús explicándoles luego las Escrituras; y, finalmente, el reconocimiento definitivo de su presencia en sus vidas durante la «fracción del pan», es decir, en la Eucaristía.

Dado que la vida misma es un camino, este episodio nos invita a reflexionar sobre nuestras propias vidas — incluyendo algunos de sus momentos más dramáticos— y a buscar en ellas la presencia de Dios, la presencia de Jesús; aunque sea simplemente «mirando hacia atrás», tal como hicieron los discípulos.

Ahora nosotros —todos nosotros— nos encontramos ante el inicio de un nuevo viaje. No necesariamente estamos ya embarcándonos en él; de hecho, antes de partir, nos queda aún mucho por preparar, por poner en orden, por despedirnos, por celebrar e incluso por llorar.

Pero un nuevo viaje —un nuevo capítulo en nuestra vida de fe— nos aguarda a todos.

De lo que sí podemos estar seguros, sin embargo, es de que Dios, en la persona de Jesús, estará con nosotros; caminará a nuestro lado mientras nos aguardan nuevas aventuras, nuevas experiencias y nuevas revelaciones. Sí, todo esto puede resultar intimidante al principio. Pero, con Dios a nuestro lado, todo saldrá bien.

Que Dios los bendiga a todos, y que sepamos apreciar las cosas nuevas que Él ha preparado para todos nosotros. ¡Feliz Tercer Domingo de Pascua!

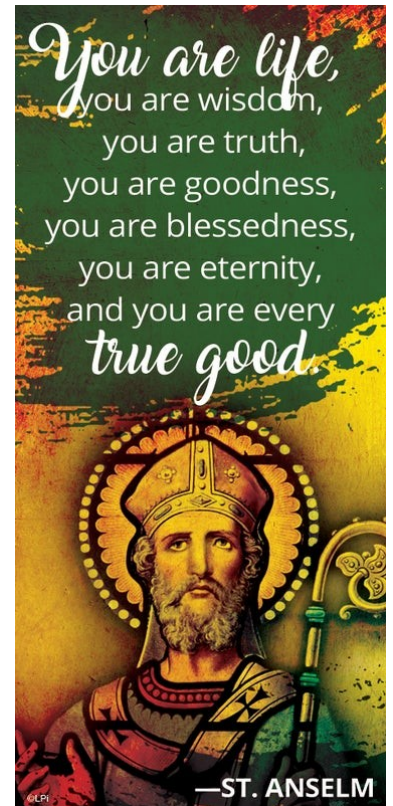

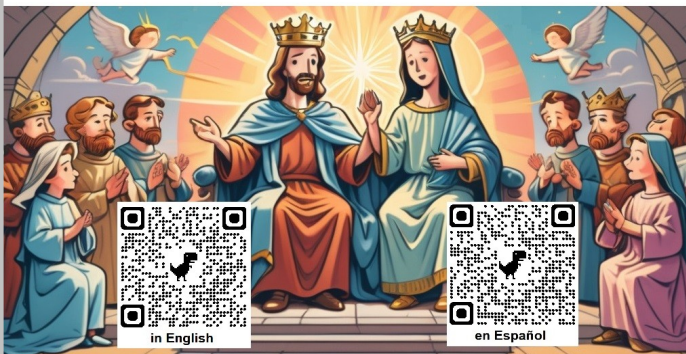
