**PASTOR PONDERINGS**

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday we celebrate the Ascension of the Lord. It's supposed to be celebrated 40 days after the Resurrection of the Lord on Easter, hence it should really have been celebrated on "Ascension Thursday." However, a good part of the Catholic Bishops Conferences around the world (we were among the last) moved the feast day to the Sunday before Pentecost.

Why? Because we don't live in a predominantly agricultural world anymore when taking a holiday, even multiple holidays, off in the middle of the week would not cause any great problem. Instead, from the time of industrialization, when schedules were very rigidly set, to even our time with more "flex"(ible) schedules, adding midweek holidays has proven to be problematic. Note that Christmas / New Years and the Fourth of July are the only civil holidays celebrated that do not fall on a particular day of the week. The rest generally are set for a Monday. The only other exception is Thanksgiving Day which falls on a Thursday and is generally celebrated as a "four day holiday" as a result.

The Bishops and the theologians advising them decided that feasts like that of the Ascension and Epiphany around Christmas time were important enough to place on a Sunday to allow these days to be celebrated and preached to a large numbers of people.

So why is the Ascension of the Lord so important? Well, it reminds us that in the Incarnation, Life, Death and Resurrection of Jesus, God's redemptive plan was completed, Jesus could thus go home, and the whole project of Creation was then set once more to its original plan:

Adam and Eve's Original Sin, had caused God's Original Plan to veer off course. It took thousands of years of careful interventions, culminating with the arrival of Jesus, to reset the course in its proper direction. Having done that, God could say "Mission Accomplished," go home (ascend to heaven) and send us then the Holy Spirit as "tech support" to keep us on track for the remainder of God's Original Project.

Does the Project seem complete? Well, reading / watching the News. No, not yet, but Jesus' Ascension is an assurance to us that **DESPITE EVERYTHING** that we see or suffer through around us, we're now on track and all will turn out well!

Happy Ascension Sunday!

**PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO**

Estimados feligreses:

Este domingo celebramos la Ascensión del Señor. Anteriormente se celebraba 40 días después de la Resurrección del Señor (el Domingo de la Pascua); por lo tanto, en realidad debería haberse celebrado el «Jueves de la Ascensión». Sin embargo, una buena parte de las Conferencias Episcopales Católicas de todo el mundo (nosotros fuimos entre los últimos en hacerlo) trasladó esta festividad al domingo anterior a Pentecostés.

¿Por qué? Porque ya no vivimos en un mundo predominantemente agrícola, donde tomarse un día libre —o varios días libres — a mitad de semana no habría causado gran problema. Pero desde la época de la industrialización —cuando los horarios laborales eran muy rígidos— hasta nuestros días —con horarios más «flexibles»—, añadir días festivos a mitad de semana ha resultado ser problemático. Observen que la Navidad y el Año Nuevo, así como el Cuatro de Julio, son los únicos días festivos civiles que se celebran aquí sin estar fijados en un día específico de la semana. Los demás, por lo general, se establecen para un lunes. La única otra excepción es el Día de Acción de Gracias, que cae en jueves y, como resultado, suele celebrarse como un «fin de semana largo» de cuatro días.

Los obispos —y los teólogos que los asesoran— decidieron que festividades como la de la Ascensión y la Epifanía (esta última, en torno a la Navidad) eran lo tan importantes como para trasladarlas a un domingo, permitiendo así que estos días fueran celebrados y predicados ante un gran número de personas.

Entonces, ¿por qué es tan importante la Ascensión del Señor? Bueno, nos recuerda que, por la Encarnación, la Vida, la Muerte y la Resurrección de Jesús, se completó el Plan Redentor de Dios; de este modo, Jesús pudo regresar a su hogar en el cielo y todo el proyecto de la Creación quedó, una vez más, reencauzado hacia su plan original:

El Pecado Original de Adán y Eva había provocado que el Plan Original de Dios se desviara de su curso. Fueron necesarios miles de años de cuidadosas intervenciones — que culminaron con la llegada de Jesús— para restablecer el rumbo en la dirección correcta. Una vez logrado esto, Dios pudo decir: «Misión cumplida», regresar a su hogar (ascender al cielo) y enviarnos entonces al Espíritu Santo como «soporte técnico» para mantenernos en el camino correcto durante el resto del Proyecto Original de Dios.

¿Parece que el Proyecto ya está completo? Bueno... basta con leer o ver las noticias. No, todavía no; pero la Ascensión de Jesús es para nosotros una garantía de que, **A PESAR DE TODO** lo que vemos o sufrimos en este mundo, ahora vamos por el buen camino y ¡todo saldrá bien!

¡Feliz Domingo de la Ascensión!
