PASTOR PONDERINGS

Dear Parishioners,

So this is my last article for you to read, and the last one written by the Servites. Next Sunday, you will have a new Pastor, IMHO, a good one Fr. Al Baca, from the Diocese.

68 years ago, as a consequence of our petition to the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, to create Servite High School in Anaheim, the Archdiocese split off a portion of St. Mary's Parish in which the new High School would exist to form St. Philip Benizi Parish. Some years later, the Diocese did the same in the area around the newly formed Rosary High School to create St. Juliana's Parish.

St. Philip Benizi Parish then both came to be and its operation was given to the Servite Order.

At the time, the whole region was growing by leaps and bounds. The first Masses were said by Fr. Ortman in a nearby roller-rink, but soon the parish church and school were constructed. And the place grew.

In the late 1980s it became clear that there was a need to begin a Spanish language ministry here at St. Philip Benizi. A few years later, it became clear that by all rights a Korean ministry should be started as well.

Since we had access to Spanish speaking Servites, a Spanish language ministry soon began, started by Fr. Giuseppe Zolla, OSM a friend of then pastor Fr. Peregrine Graffius, OSM, and later the ministry was taken up by Fr. Manuel Maya, OSM for many years. Fr. David Gallegos, OSM subsequently took over both the Hispanic Ministry and above all pastorship at St. Philip's.

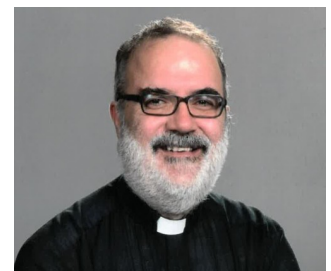
With regard to Korean Ministry, we were not equipped to do so, so an arrangement was made that a Diocesan run St. Thomas Korean Catholic Center be established within the parish grounds. Fr. Peregrine also opened the door then to the Indonesian Community to begin having Mass at the Parish though until recently – with the happy arrival of Fr Sebastian Mulu, OSM that ministry too had to be staffed by non Servite priests. And then a Filipino community for whom we would have had Servite priests started coming to the parish and building a ministry as well.

Cultural richness did not necessarily translate into economic richness however, and the parish -- along with most of the parishes in this part of the diocese – went into some economic challenge.

That economic challenge ultimately makes it important for the Diocese to return to being in charge of St. Philip Benizi. There are things that do need to be done in this part of the Diocese and the Diocese should be in charge.

We Servites have all loved this place and will continue to have fond memories of it. But it's time for us to bow our heads and say goodbye. Vayamos con Dios amigos!

PENSAMIENTOS DE NUESTRO PARROCO

Estimados feligreses:

Este es el último artículo de mi parte, y también el último escrito por los Servitas. El próximo domingo tendrán un nuevo párroco —en mi humilde opinión, uno muy bueno—: el P. Al Baca, de la diócesis.

Hace 68 años, a raíz de nuestra solicitud a la Arquidiócesis de Los Ángeles para fundar la escuela secundaria Servite High School en Anaheim, la Arquidiócesis segregó una parte de la parroquia de St. Mary —donde se ubicaría la nueva escuela— para crear la parroquia de St. Philip Benizi. Años más tarde, la diócesis hizo lo mismo en los alrededores de la recién creada Rosary High School para establecer la parroquia de St. Juliana.

Así nació la parroquia de St. Philip Benizi, cuya administración fue encomendada a la Orden de los Servitas.

Por aquel entonces, toda la región experimentaba un crecimiento acelerado. El P. Ortman celebró las primeras misas en una pista de patinaje cercana, pero pronto se construyeron la iglesia parroquial y la escuela. El lugar siguió creciendo.

A finales de la década de 1980, se hizo evidente la necesidad de iniciar un ministerio en español aquí en St. Philip Benizi. Pocos años después, quedó claro que también era justo y necesario poner en marcha un ministerio para la comunidad coreana.

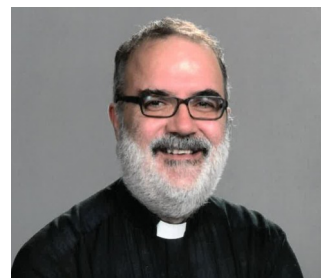
Como contábamos con servitas de habla hispana, pronto se inició un ministerio en español, impulsado por el P. Giuseppe Zolla, OSM —amigo del entonces párroco, el P. Peregrine Graffius, OSM—, labor que más tarde continuó durante muchos años el P. Manuel Maya, OSM. P. David Gallegos, tomó responsabilidad por el ministerio hispano, y sobre todo el papel de párroco después.

En cuanto al ministerio coreano, al no disponer de los recursos necesarios para atenderlo directamente, se acordó establecer el Centro Católico Coreano St. Thomas —gestionado por la diócesis— dentro de los terrenos de la parroquia. El P. Peregrine también abrió las puertas a la comunidad indonesia para celebrar misa en la parroquia; sin embargo, hasta hace poco —con la feliz llegada del P. Sebastian Mulu, OSM—, dicho ministerio tuvo que ser atendido por sacerdotes que no eran servitas. Asimismo, comenzó a asistir a la parroquia una comunidad filipina que, tendríamos sacerdotes servitas para su atención, también fue desarrollando su propio ministerio. Sin embargo, la riqueza cultural no se traducía necesariamente en prosperidad económica, y la parroquia —al igual que la mayoría de las parroquias de esta zona de la diócesis— comenzó a enfrentar dificultades económicas.

Dichas dificultades económicas hacen que, en última instancia, sea importante que la diócesis retome la administración de la parroquia de San Felipe Benizi. Es necesario enfrentar ciertas realidades en esta parte de la diócesis y es importante que la diócesis tiene la libertad de hacerlas.

Nosotros, los servitas, hemos amado este lugar y guardaremos siempre gratos recuerdos de él. Pero ha llegado el momento de inclinar la cabeza y despedirnos. ¡Vayamos todos con Dios, amigos!

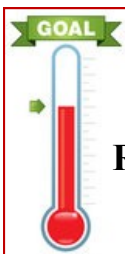
