

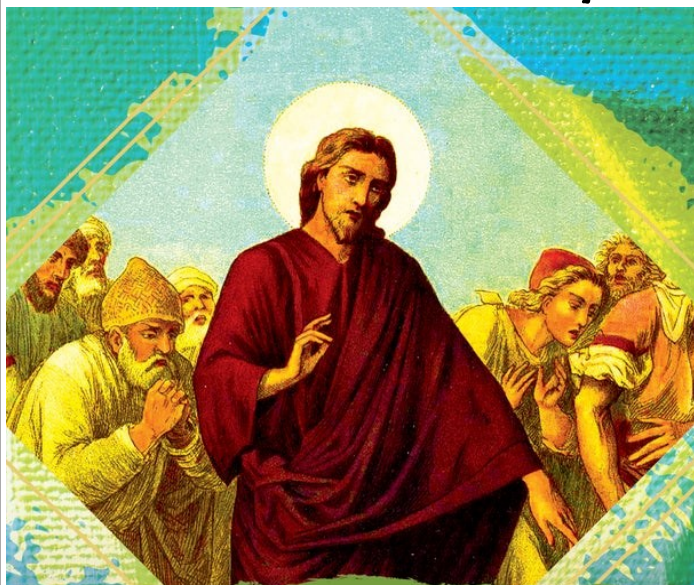

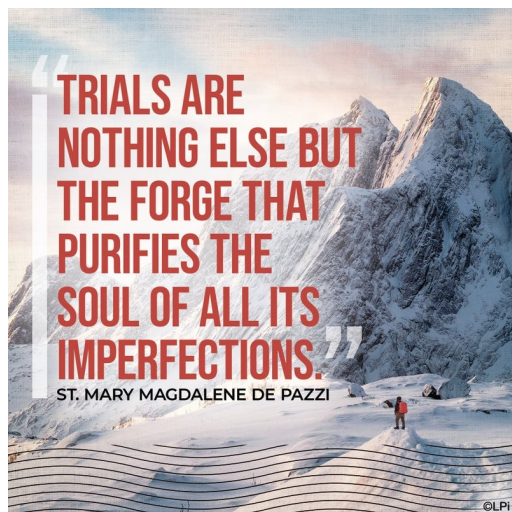

PASTORS CORNER

Dear Friends,

Since arriving to St Philip, there are a few changes you might have noticed.

You may hear the bells rung 4 times in place of 2 times in past Masses. The Missal book that guides the priest at Mass, states that the bells can be rung at the *Epiclesis*, when during the Eucharistic Prayer, the priest places his hands over the bread and wine, transforming them into the real Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. They can be rung when the Eucharist and Precious Blood are raised up for adoration. In place of one long ring of the bells we are now ringing the bells 3 times.

Then after the Lamb of God (Agnus Dei) is sung or recited the bell rings as you are kneeling. The sound of bells is beautiful. They alert us to important moments in the Mass and call us to prayer and adoration.

Something that in time will be noticed by you is that Bishop Vann has given permission to place a tabernacle in the church, beneath the central crucifix. This means that the church will soon be open from before the 8:30am Mass and close at 9pm. At 9pm, the Blessed Sacrament Chapel will be available for prayer until the 8:30am Mass the next day. You will have access to the Blessed Sacrament 24 hours a day.

We have the opportunity to purchase the tabernacle that was at St Anne Church in Santa Ana. It has been refurbished and regilded. The cost of the tabernacle is \$15,000.00 which is not expensive for a large tabernacle. Already a number of parishioners have given toward the tabernacle. Please consider helping us. Every little bit helps.

Once we have purchased the tabernacle, we will construct a wooden backdrop to frame the tabernacle under the great cross.

Please enjoy the picture of our new tabernacle!

**RINCON DEL PASTOR**

Queridos amigos,

Desde que llegamos a San Felipe, hay algunos cambios que quizá hayan notado.

Pueden oír las campanas sonar 4 veces en lugar de 2 veces en Misas pasadas. El libro de Misales que guía al sacerdote en la Misa afirma que las campanas pueden escurrirse en la *Epiclesis*, cuando durante la Oración Eucarística, el sacerdote coloca sus manos sobre el pan y el vino, transformándolos en el verdadero Cuerpo y Sangre de Jesucristo. Pueden sonarse cuando la Eucaristía y la Preciosa Sangre se levantan para la adoración. En lugar de un largo timbre de campanas, ahora tocamos las campanas 3 veces.

Luego, después de cantar o recitar el Cordero de Dios (Agnus Dei), la campana suena mientras están arrodillados. El sonido de las campanas es precioso. Nos alertan sobre momentos importantes de la Misa y nos llaman a la oración y la adoración.

Algo que con el tiempo notarán es que el obispo Vann ha dado permiso para colocar un tabernáculo en la iglesia, bajo el crucifijo central. Esto significa que la Iglesia pronto se abrirá antes de la Misa de las 8:30 am y cerrará a las 9:00 pm. A las 9:00 pm, la Capilla del Santísimo Sacramento estará disponible para la oración hasta la Misa de las 8:30 del día siguiente. Tendrán acceso al Santísimo Sacramento las 24 horas del día.

Tenemos la oportunidad de comprar el tabernáculo que estaba en la iglesia de Santa Ana en Santa Ana. Ha sido renovado y regillado. El costo del tabernáculo es de 15,000 dólares, lo cual no es caro para un tabernáculo grande. Ya varios feligreses han donado hacia el tabernáculo. Por favor, consideren ayudarnos. Cada pequeña donacion ayuda.

Una vez que hayamos comprado el sagrario, construiremos un fondo de madera para enmarcar el tabernáculo bajo la gran cruz.

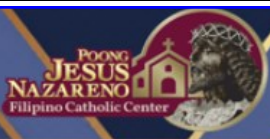
GOSPEL
